### **ALTERNATE SECURITY PROVISIONS**

Section 6704 allows for alternates to the specific Security Provisions of Chapter 67 of the Building Code, when the approval of such alternates is based upon a recommendation of the <u>County Sheriff</u> and concurrence from the <u>Fire Department</u> per Section 14051 of the Penal Code. Requests for the approval of alternate methods of complying with the Security Provisions should be handled according to the following policy and procedure.

When an applicant, contractor or property owner proposes alternates to specific or general requirements of Chapter 67 (Security Provisions), the proposal should first be evaluated by the Plan Check Engineer in conjunction with the District Office Manager. When the Office Manager believes the proposal is not reasonable or equivalent, the applicant should be so informed. If the proposal has merit, or if the applicant wishes further consideration of a denied request, the applicant may submit his specific proposal on the proper form (copy attached) to the Sheriff's Department. The proposal should not be sent until after payment of the fees prescribed in Section 104.2.8. The Research Section may also be consulted for advice or assistance, if necessary.

The applicant must submit specific detailed proposals to this Division including all supporting documentation. This request will be forwarded along with a letter from the Office Manager to the Sheriff's Department requesting an inspection and/or an evaluation of the proposal. The package should be directed to the Crime Preventions/Community Affairs detail of the local Sheriff station (see Page 2 for list of local stations). The Office Manager or other designated personnel of this Division should feel free to contact the Crime Prevention officers on these matters.

Applicants are not to be referred to the Sheriff's office or instructed to contact the Sheriff directly.
