## **MEETING SUMMARY**

## 1. Welcome and Introductions

• Attendees were welcomed and participants introduced themselves

## 2. Recap Previous Meeting

- We covered the pilot Organics Management Plan being developed in response to AB 1826 and the efforts towards developing a food donation program in Los Angeles County
- Presentation by Andre Villaseñor from the US Environmental Protection Agency at the September Working Group meeting
- The Resources page of the Roadmap site is now live

## 3. Pharmaceuticals Extended Producer Responsibility

Strategy 1-Initiative B; Also Regional Countywide Strategy 1-Initiative B; and County Operations Strategy 1-Initiative B

Gabriel Arenas, Public Works, presentation (slides start at #33)

- The pharmaceutical working group created a Technical Advisory Group (TAG) from a list of stakeholders that would be affected by the new ordinance
- The TAG has met twice so far and plans to meet with the public on November 13, 2015
- The Ordinance will be submitted to the Board by February 9, 2016

## 4. Waste Characterization Study

Strategy 2-Initiave A

Chris Sheppard, Public Works, presentation (slides start at #37)

- The State Waste Characterization Study is similar to the waste assessments done at County departments but on a statewide scale
- Designed to determine types and amounts of paper, food, glass, metal, etc. in each waste stream

- Not only looking at disposal but also generation for the commercial waste
- Looks at contamination of green and blue bins
- In Southern California, 3 sites were identified for disposal sampling
- Generator study looked at 889 businesses categorized by business type
- A question was raised whether socio-economic factors were taken into account in the study. This was not considered but can be analyzed after the fact using zip codes and census tracts.
- Our proposed study would be similar to the State study, but for LA County
  - o 3 sectors to be analyzed include: residential, commercial and self-haul
- We will have random sampling from each of the Garbage Disposal Districts
- AB 1826 defines a business as the property owner
  - o A strip mall with multiple tenants will count as a combined "business"
- We should consider developing an FAQ, similar to CalRecycle but for use by LA County businesses

## 5. Eliminating Items from our Waste Stream

Strategy 1-Initiative A and C

- What are items we see in the waste stream that we could ban? Plastic bag ban for example
  - o Styrofoam revisiting a Styrofoam ban should be considered. Styrofoam is currently not allowed in County facilities.
  - o Plastic bottles alternatives include reusable bottles, hydration stations
    - Some schools have issues with water quality
- Plastic film is very difficult for MRFs and currently has very little market value
- Mixed rigid plastics currently have very low value, which fluctuates with oil prices
- Waxed cardboard and cartons can't be baled, or only in small quantities

## 6. Promoting Reusable Items

Strategy 1-Initiative A; Also County Operations Strategy 1-Initiative A

## 7. Open Discussion and Next Steps

- Sanitation Districts' organics pilot had their first food waste load this week
  - 3-4% contamination rate, including green waste, cartons and sealed plastic bags of vegetables
  - Meats CAN be included
- The group decided to forgo the November subcommittee meeting and have the Working Group meeting in December
