I hereby certify that the line of the Rancho as shown upon this map
is the line as located by the callings of the Patent from known monuments
on the original boundaries of said Rancho, except the corner "S.P. 31" which is
located as a compromise corner; and as it is so described in the field notes
of the survey of the original patent boundary, said boundary appears to have
been the line of ordinary high tide of the Pacific Ocean as it existed on the
date of the survey of said patent boundary. -- And further that the
sand dunes and sand now existing between said boundary of Rancho
San Pedro and the present line of ordinary high tide of the Pacific Ocean
are the result of accretions formed by the imperceptible and gradual
accumulations of sand upon the shore of the Pacific Ocean, from natural causes.




