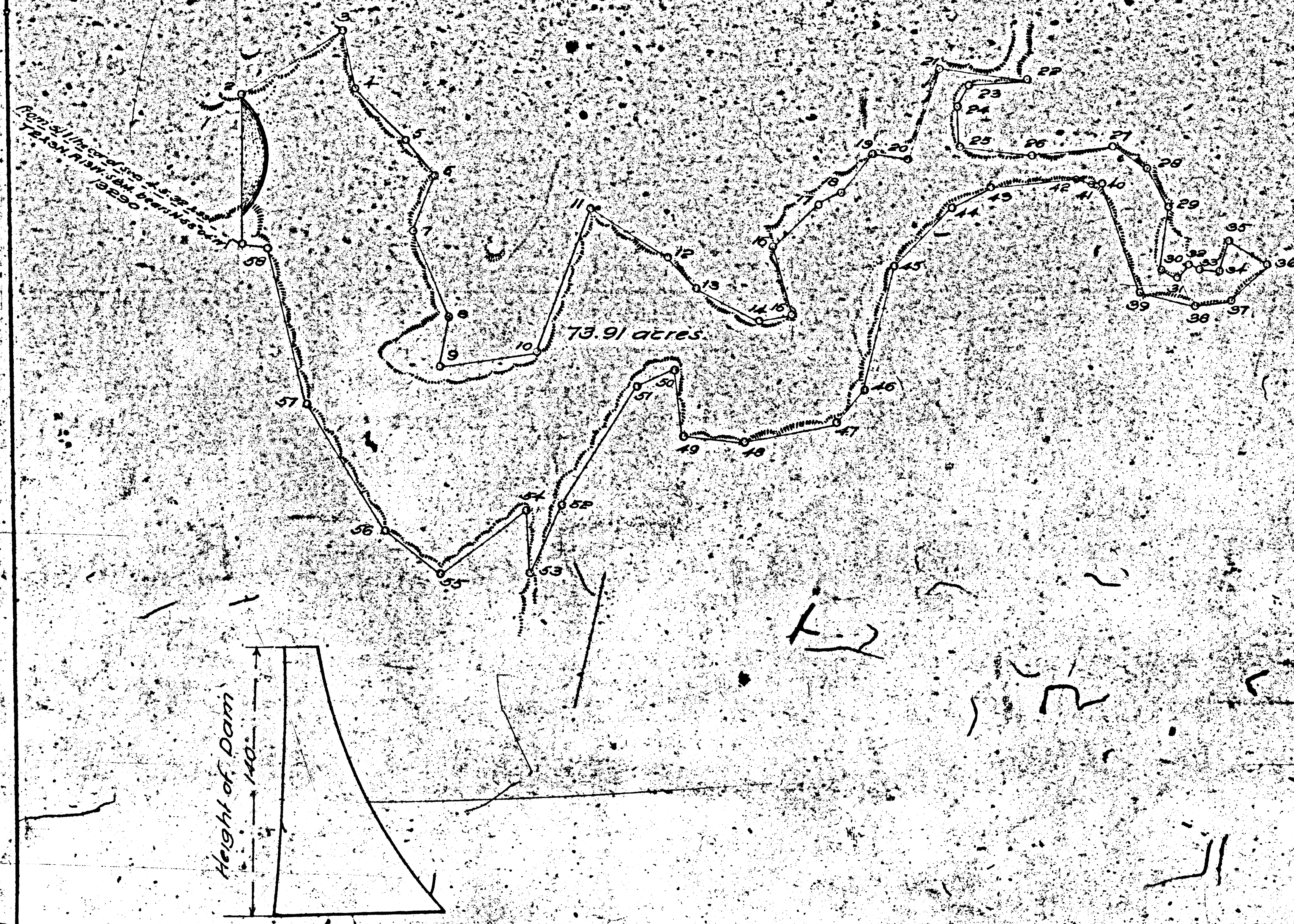




MAP

I, L. Friel, being duly sworn, depose that he is the person employed as engineer to make the survey by Samuel Merrill, the owner and claimant of the reservoir set forth and shown on the map on which this is indorsed, that the survey of said Samuel Merrill's reservoir described as follows (on unsurveyed land) begins at a point station 1, whence the corner of Sections 4, 5, 32, and 33 T 2 and 3 N. R 13 W. S 3 B M. bears N 56° 04' W 13290 feet and a total area of 73.91 acres was made by him as surveyor and engineer for said Samuel Merrill and under his authority commencing on the 21st day of August 1895 and ending on the 23rd day of August 1895 and that the survey of the said reservoir accurately represents a level line which is the proposed water line of the said reservoir and that such survey is accurately represented upon the map and by the accompanying field notes and no lake, lake bed, stream or stream bed is used for the said reservoir except as shown on this map

I, Samuel Merrill do hereby certify that I am the owner and claimant of the reservoir set forth and shown in the map on which this is indorsed, that L. Friel who subscribed the accompanying affidavit is the engineer employed by me to make the survey, that the survey of the said reservoir as accurately represented on this map and by the accompanying field notes was made under my authority, that the said reservoir as represented on this map and by said field notes was adopted by me on the 3rd day of January 1896 as the definite location of the said reservoir and described as follows (on unsurveyed land) beginning at station 1, whence the corner of sections 4, 5, 32 and 33 T 2 and 3 N. R 13 W. S 3 B M. bears N 56° 04' W 13290 feet and a total area of 73.91 acres and that no lake, or lake bed, or stream bed is used for the said reservoir except as shown on this map and that the map has been prepared to be filed for the approval of the Secretary of the Interior in order that I may obtain the benefit of section 1816 of the act of Congress approved March 3, 1891 entitled "An act to repeal timber culture laws, and for other purposes"
