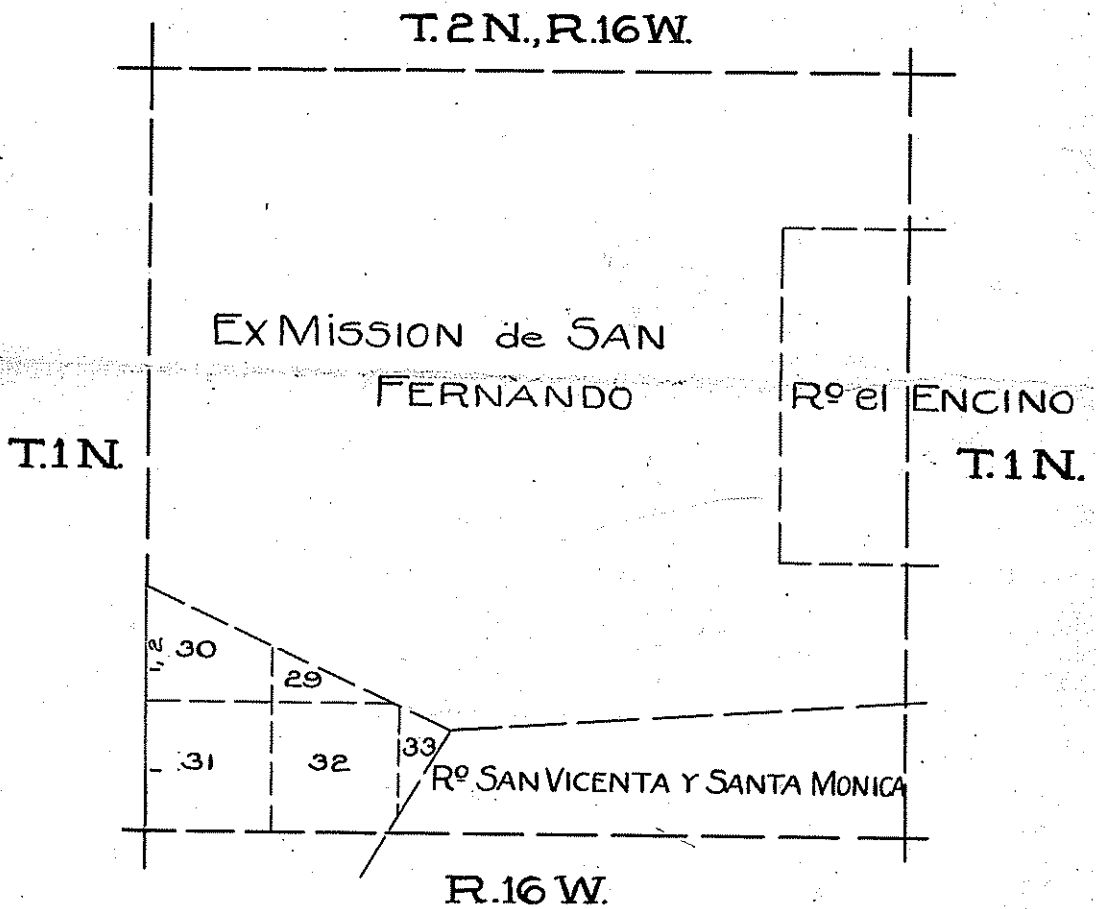


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Field Notes of the west line of Section 30, Township  
1 North, Range 16 West, San Bernardino Meridian.

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From the corner to Townships 1 North and 1 South,  
Ranges 16 and 17 West, San Bernardino Base Line,  
previously set by me, I run North between sections 31 and  
36. Variation 14° 30' East.

80.00 Set a sandstone 28 x 18 x 10 inches, 21 inches in the ground  
for corner to sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked with 1  
notch on the south and 5 notches on the north edge and  
raised a stone mound alongside.

Pits impracticable.

Soil third rate.

Scattering oak timber and dense undergrowth of chaparral.

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North between sections 25 and 30.

Variation 14° 30' East.

Ascend.

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5.50 Top of spur bears E. and W. and descend.

8.00 Cross gulch 6 links wide, course S. 45° East and ascend.

11.50 Top of ridge bears E. and W. and descend.

14.50 Cross gulch 4 links wide, course S. 45° E. and ascend.

21.50 Top of ridge bears E. and W. and descend.

35.00 Cross gulch 4 links wide, course N. W. and ascend.

40.00 Set a post 3 feet long, 3 inches square, 24 inches in the  
ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on W. face;  
from which bears a

Live oak, 16 inches in diameter, S. 12° E. 92 links distant,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B. T.

A live oak 18 inches in diameter, S. 10 W. 151 links distant  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B. T.

Corner set on top of spur which bears N. W. and S. E.

Descend.

55.12 Cross gulch 8 links wide, course N. 40° W. and ascend.

58.00 Top of spur bears N. W. and S. E. and descend.

60.00 Enter cultivated land, bears E. and W.

62.00 Cross road bears E. and W.

69.00 Leave cultivated land, bears E. and W.

70.10 Cross gulch 10 links wide, course N.E. and ascend.  
72.86 Intersect boundary line of Ex Mission San Fernando,  
9.00 chains S. 65° 24' E. from  $\frac{1}{40}$  corner on line,  
previously set by me; set a limestone 16 x 12 x 8 inches,  
11 inches in the ground for closing corner to Townships  
1 North, Ranges 16 and 17 West, marked C. C. with 6 notches  
on the south, east and west edges;

From which bears

A black walnut tree 8 inches in diameter, S. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W.  
97 links distant, marked T. 1 N., R. 17 W., S. 25 B. T.  
No other trees within limits.

Raised a stone mound alongside corner stone.

Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous and broken.

Soil second and third rate.

Scattering oak timber and dense undergrowth of chaparral.
