

 hereby certify that the plat hereof attached is a correct plat of lands  
 selected by the Southern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation  
 under the laws of the state of California and necessary for the right  
 of way of a spur track from the Wilmington Branch Division of  
 the Southern Pacific Railroad along the easterly side of Wilmington  
 Channel to Mormon Island and for the construction thereon of yards  
 side tracks, spur tracks, depot buildings, warehouses, wharves and  
 other adjuncts to facilitate the transportation of freight & passengers  
 to and from Wilmington Bay, Los Angeles Co. California, commencing  
 at Eng Sta 15+90 on the existing main track of the said Wilmington  
 branch leading to the Railroad Wharf at the Town of Wilmington and  
 being four thousand one hundred & thirteen feet in length along the  
 located center line of said spur track and two hundred feet in width  
 lying equally on each side of the said located center line, following  
 the curvatures of said located center line and containing an area  
 of 18.28 acres more or less.




