

Santa Monica, Nov. 23<sup>d</sup> 1899

Description of Oregon Avenue Extension from 27<sup>th</sup> St. to the westerly line of the Barrett Villa Tract, Sawtelle.

Situate in the Rancho San Vicente Y Santa Monica. County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Being a strip of land one hundred feet in width, the point of commencement for the center line thereof located as follows towit; -

Commencing at a point in the center line of Oregon Avenue as now existing, South westerly and distant 33.81 feet from the point of intersection of the center line of 27<sup>th</sup> Street with the center line of Oregon Avenue, thence Northeasterly N. 61° 35' E distant 66.5 feet to a point in the Easterly line of 27<sup>th</sup> Street being the point of beginning of the center line of the 100 foot strip to be herein conveyed, thence running N. 61° 35' E distant 4683.95 feet to a point in the westerly line of the Barrett Villa Tract Sawtelle distant 429 feet Southeasterly from a Stone Monument placed at the S.W. corner of the 300 Acre Tract of the National Home for D.V.S. Pacific Branch.

The above strip of land to be hereby conveyed being subject to the right of way which has been granted to the Los Angeles Pacific R.R. Company.

Reference is hereby made to the accompanying plat.

Also intending to convey the above described strip of land in exchange for the abandonment of all that portion of Railroad Avenue lying between 27<sup>th</sup> Street and the Westerly boundary line of the Barrett Villa Tract
