Airport Improvement Projects

Consolidated Aircraft Run-up Area

Consistent with recommendations from the Community Advisory Committee as part of its re-envisioning process for Whiteman Airport and to help to minimize impacts from aircraft operations on the surrounding communities, Public Works submitted a proposal to the FAA to consolidate the aircraft run-up areas at each end of Runway 12/30 into a single run-up area to be located midfield. The proposal is currently under review by the FAA.

Repair Updates

Northside Power Pole

The power pole and conduits on the northside of the airport serving the control tower gate were damaged during the recent high winds. Necessary parts are expected to be installed and power restored to the gate in October.

Whiteman Airport Land Use Study and Economic Analysis

The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved \$1.3 million for the Department of Economic Opportunity to conduct a Land Use Study and Economic Analysis of Whiteman Airport.

The study is underway and expected to be completed by the end of this year. It includes a four-phase approach including: 1) Confirmation of Airport Closure Process; 2) Existing Conditions Analysis; 3) Options for Development Incorporating Stakeholder Input; and 4) Economic Impact Analysis of Preferred Options.

The consulting firm conducting the study, Trifiletti Consulting, is meeting individually with various stakeholders now to solicit inputs and plans to hold various Open House events later this Fall as part of its stakeholder and community engagement efforts.
