



- Project will divert urban and stormwater runoff into drywells within existing roadway medians
- Above-ground improvements
  - Drought tolerant landscaping
  - Picnic Tables/Benches
  - Walking Paths
  - Exercise Equipment
  - Educational Signage





#### **Budget**

- Total Estimated Project Cost: \$36M
- Project Partners:
  - Los Angeles County
  - Los Angeles County Flood Control District
  - Monterey Park
  - Montebello
- Other Funding Sources: \$4.5M
  - Prop 1 Stormwater \$2M
  - CA Urban Greening Grant \$2.5M





#### <u>Schedule</u>

- Begin Construction July 2020
- Complete Construction Fall 2021

#### **Construction Impacts**

- Closure of medians
- Traffic Control


