Thank you for attending our mandatory Proposers' Conference for Operating Food and Vending Machine Services (2011-PA007) held on Tuesday, May 10, 2011. Please take note of the following revisions that have been addressed regarding the Request for Proposals (RFP).

Please note that **bold underlined** text has been added, and any text that has a ~~strikethrough~~ has been deleted from the RFP.

The deadline to submit proposals is still **Wednesday, June 8, 2011, by 5:30 p.m.**

ADDENDUM

1. In Part II, Exhibit A, Scope of Work, the final paragraph of section P., Removal of Debris/Garbage, Kitchen Compostable Waste, and Cardboard, on page A.12, of the RFP has been deleted:

~~The Contractor is advised that discarded hazardous waste may be encountered during the performance of this contract. In the event an unknown substance or hazardous material is discovered, the Contractor shall immediately notify the Contract Manager. The Contractor shall NOT attempt to perform any type of hazardous waste remediation not included under the Scope of Work of this Contract, including identifying, containing, cleaning, moving, disposing, etc. The Contractor shall exercise extreme caution in the event unknown waste is encountered.~~

2. Part II, Exhibit A, Scope of Work, paragraph Y., Hazardous Materials, on page A.18, of the RFP has been revised as follows.

Y. Hazardous Materials

The Contractor shall not allow or permit to remain on the Premises any offensive matter or refuse material, which could create a possible fire hazard, or other substance containing an unnecessary, unreasonable, or unlawful material detrimental to public health. The Contractor shall prevent any accumulation thereof from occurring.

The Contractor is advised that discarded hazardous waste may be encountered during the performance of this Contract. In the event an unknown substance or hazardous material is discovered, the Contractor shall immediately notify the Contract Manager. The Contractor shall NOT attempt to perform any type of hazardous waste remediation not included under the Scope of Work of this Contract, including identifying, containing, cleaning, moving, disposing, etc. The Contractor shall exercise extreme caution in the event unknown waste is encountered.
