INVITATION FOR BIDS - ADDENDUM 2 ATHENS/WOODCREST/OLIVITA, FIRESTONE, AND WALNUT PARK GARBAGE DISPOSAL DISTRICTS (BRC0000125)

Thank you for attending our mandatory bidders' conference for Athens/Woodcrest/Olivita, Firestone, and Walnut Park Garbage Disposal Districts (BRC0000125) held on Thursday, February 20, 2020.

Please note that the deadline for bid submission is **Monday, March 2, 2020, by 5:30 p.m.**

All addenda and informational updates will be posted at http://pw.lacounty.gov/brcd/servicecontracts. Please check the website frequently for any changes to this solicitation.

Please take note of the following revisions to the Invitation For Bids (IFB). (Note that the changes that have been added are in **boldface** and deleted languages are strikethrough.)

A. Addendum

1. Part 1, Sample Contract, Section 7, Service Fees and Billing, Item C.3.a.(2) More than Four Cubic Yards, has been deleted in its entirety.

CONTRACTOR may request an extra fee per incident equal to the more than four cubic yards rate for a volume greater than four cubic yards. This is compensation for the additional time required to clean up a larger pile of Abandoned Waste. CONTRACTOR shall take and submit before and after photos of the waste to request a higher fee for that location. These special circumstances must be itemized separately on the invoice.

2. Part 1, Sample Contract, Section 7, Service Fees and Billing, Item C.3.b.(3) Waste Collection from All Hot Zone Locations, has been deleted in its entirety.

CONTRACTOR may request a fee equal to the number of incidents of Waste Collection from All Hot Zone Locations with four cubic yards or less rate. All Hot Zones refers to the original locations indicated in CONTRACT and not any that are added after the Execution Date.

The four cubic yards volume refers to the total amount of waste at a single incident, not the total collected in all Hot Zones. For example, five piles of two cubic yards is billed at this rate and is not considered ten cubic yards. Waste separated by more than ten feet shall be considered a separate incident. CONTRACTOR is required to use Director's Trash Monitoring Program (TMP) smartphone application, or other system as determined by Director, to record information such as the location, brief description, and photographs of Collected Abandoned Waste.

3. Part 1, Sample Contract, Section 7, Service Fees and Billing, Item C.3.b.(4) Additional Hot Zone Waste Collection, has been deleted in its entirety.

After the Execution Date, if Hot Zones are created or expanded greater than the length indicated in Item 16.A.2 of Exhibit 16, CONTRACTOR may request a fee equal to the number of incidents of Additional Hot Zone Waste Collection with four cubic yards or less rate for the additional distance only.

The four cubic yards volume refers to the total amount of waste at a single incident, not the total collected in all Hot Zones. Waste separated by more than ten feet may be considered a separate incident. CONTRACTOR is not required to provide evidence of Collection unless Director requests. CONTRACTOR is required to record the location of each incident and submit with the monthly invoice.

4. Part 1, Sample Contract, Section 7, Service Fees and Billing, Item C.3.b.(5) Waste Collection with More Than Four Cubic Yards, has been deleted in its entirety.

For any incident larger than four cubic yards, CONTRACTOR may request an extra fee equal to the per incident Waste Collection with more than four cubic yards rate. Waste separated by more than ten feet shall be considered a separate incident. CONTRACTOR shall take and submit

before and after photos of the waste to request a higher fee for that location. These special circumstances must be itemized separately on the invoice.
