Questions and Answers

The following answers are in response to the request for information and clarification and other questions submitted by Proposers for the On-Call Pump Pulling, Machine Repair, Motor Control, and Well Maintenance Services (BRC0000016). Questions presented in this Informational Update represent the questions asked by the Proposers in the form and context submitted.

1. **Question:** Is Antelope Valley Watermaster only responsible for installation of meter? Or Installation of the water pumps?

Answer: The Watermaster compliance portion of the RFP focuses on work related to the accuracy of the well meters and does not include work on the water pumps. As indicated in Exhibit A, Scope of Work, Section P.3, Additional Responsibilities of the Contractor, the Antelope Valley Watermaster is responsible for establishing the proper installation and testing procedures and equipment needed to install and test meters to ensure compliance with Antelope Valley Groundwater Adjudication. The Contractor must adhere to these requirements.

2. **Question:** We would like to make a formal request that the bid opening date for this proposal be extended beyond the current due date of January 3, 2019. With upcoming December holidays, end of year vacation days and new year's

days off most proposers will be limited with personnel available to work on this proposal. Therefore, we ask that bid date be extended at least another week to ensure completion and submittal of this proposal in a more timely matter.

Answer: The deadline for proposal submission has been extended to <u>Monday, January 14, 2019, at 5:30 p.m.</u>

3. **Question:** Please advise if subcontractors will be approved for this RFP. We have a C61/D21 license, but we are without the C-57 license.

Answer: As indicated in Part I, Section B, Minimum Mandatory Requirements, of the RFP, the use of subcontractors is prohibited for this service, except for extraordinary work, consulting, or specialized services (i.e., well video services, well liner screen repairs, chemical analysis, and chemical delivery based on Scope of Work. Such subcontractors, if not submitted in the proposal, will require prior approval from the Contract Manager. As for the state licenses, **proposer** must hold the State of California Licenses for C-57, Well Drilling; and C-61, subcategory D-21, Machinery and Pumps, Contractor Licenses.
