REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS – ADDENDUM 1 AS-NEEDED LEAK DETECTION PROGRAM (2009-AN017)

Thank you for attending our mandatory Proposers' Conference for As-Needed Leak Detection Program (2009-AN017) on Tuesday, May 19, 2009. The following are revisions to the Request for Proposals (RFP) as well as responses to questions asked. (Please note that **bold** text has been added and any text that has a ~~strikethrough~~ has been deleted from the RFP.)

Revisions:

1. The RFP notice has been revised to read as follows:

Minimum Requirement(s): Proposers must meet all minimum requirements set forth in the RFP document, including, but not limited to, Proposer or its managing employee must have a minimum of three years' experience performing the type of service solicited. Additionally, Proposer must submit copies of ~~the Proposer's California Business License~~, the Proposer and/or subcontractor, latest calibration certifications by the National Bureau of Standards or its equivalent, and any other appropriate State licenses and certifications required to perform the work, if any.

2. Part I, Section 1, Item B.2, Minimum Mandatory Requirements (page 1.1) has been revised to read as follows:
 1. Proposer or its managing employee must have a minimum of three years' experience performing the type of service solicited.
 2. ~~Proposer must submit copies of the Proposer's California Business License.~~
 3. 2. Proposer and/or subcontractor must submit copies of the latest calibration certifications by the National Bureau of Standards or its equivalent.

3. Part I, Section 2, Item A.9, License and Certifications (page 1.10) has been revised to read as follows:

9. Licenses and Certifications

Submit copies of the ~~Proposer's California Business License~~, the Proposer's and/or subcontractor's, latest calibration certifications by the National Bureau of Standards and any other appropriate State licenses and certifications required to perform the work, if any.

4. Part I, Section 4, Item D.7, Initial Review (page 1.22) has been revised to read as follows:

7. Proposer has submitted a ~~California Business License~~, copies of the Proposer's and/or subcontractor's, latest calibration certifications by the National Bureau of Standards or its equivalent, and any other appropriate State license(s) and certification(s) required to perform the service.

Proposers who do not possess and/or have listed subcontractors who do not possess the required licenses/certifications/permits at the proposal deadline date will be disqualified as nonresponsive.

5. Exhibit A, Scope of Work, Section J, Responsibilities of the Contractor (page A.5) has been revised to read as follows:

1. **Prior to the start of any work, submit proof of a valid California Business License.**

Questions:

1. **Question:** For Item 3, in Form PW-2, Schedule of Prices, what is the largest diameter for metallic pipes 16 inches and larger in diameter?

Response: The largest diameter for the steel pipes is actually 48 inches and not 30 inches as stated in the Conference.

2. **Question:** For Item 2, in Form PW-2, Schedule of Prices, what are the nonmetallic pipes 2 inches to 14 inches in diameter made of?

Response: The nonmetal pipes are made of asbestos cement (A/C).

Clarification:

1. On Form PW-2, Schedule of Prices, the number of units is only an estimate and is only provided as historical data for past utilization and to allow us to compare prices. The unit prices quoted, if any, will apply to the actual quantities, whatever they may be.

The deadline to submit proposals is Wednesday, June 3, 2009, at 5:30 p.m.
