#### **QUESTION AND ANSWER**

Question presented in this Addendum represents the question asked by the Proposers in the form and context submitted.

1. Question: I have a quick question on the PW form 2.3, section 2E- Litter Collection. If you see below, the third item, Litter rate per hour is "As Needed" but the formula is multiplying by 4.33 which implies that we will be doing that service every day of the week. It is almost double counting, as we already have the rate per mile for each day. Due to that the required revenue for Task 2 might seem to be overstated. Please clarify, how to approach this.

**Response:** Multiplying all services under the litter section by 4.33 weeks is correct. This allows us to calculate an estimated maximum amount.
