Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Scope of Work consists of refurbishing the library entrance to include a walkway that meets current Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility standards, repair and upgrades to the building's low voltage, information technology, telecommunication systems, exterior and interior finishes, and the replacement of the signage, bookshelves, and furniture. The refurbished library would include a periodical reading room; a study lounge; an adult, teen, and children areas; a multipurpose community room; two group study rooms; express service self-checkout machines; public access computers; and Wi Fi internet access.
