If the property is maintained by CSMD and a stub is not available to connect to, the permits listed in the New Sewer Connection section below are all required.		
NEW SEWER CONNECTION		
The f	following permits are required for a new sewer connection:	
	 Sewer Connection Permit Permits for incorporated areas are issued by the city (see Service Locator for contact information). Permits for unincorporated areas are issued through EPIC LA (epicla.lacounty.gov) or by Public Works Building and Safety Division (B&S) (see Service Locator for contact information). 	
	 Tap and Saddle Installation Permit Permits are issued through EPIC LA or by B&S. Permits are only issued for properties that need to connect a new saddle into the mainline. Accessory Dwellings Units (ADU) are typically connected to the existing lateral and do not require a Tap and Saddle. 	
	Road Excavation Permit Permits for incorporated areas are issued by the city. Permits for unincorporated areas are issued by Public Works Land Development Division.
