CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE

Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 29, in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, has determined that, after comprehensive testing, your water is safe to drink. It is no longer necessary to boil tap water before use.

On August 6, 2025, customers in the area shown on the attached map were notified to boil/disinfect all tap water used for drinking and cooking. That notice has now been lifted.

Before using your water, please complete the following steps:

- 1. Flush outdoor hose spigots**
Turn on each spigot for at least 2 minutes, or until the water runs clear.
- 2. Flush indoor faucets and fixtures**
Run both cold and hot water from all faucets (sinks, showers, tubs, etc.) for at least 2 minutes, or until the water runs clear.
- 3. Discard any ice**
Throw out any ice made with tap water during the boil water notice period.

These steps will help remove any remaining sediment or discoloration in the lines.



