



# BOBCAT FIRE and LAKE FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL

## **HOW WILL YOU REMOVE FIRE DEBRIS?**

Property owners with fire debris on their properties **MUST** apply for one of two options:

### **OPTION 1 (OPT-IN):**

Commercial and publicly-owned properties will be considered on a case-by-case basis

The Government-sponsored Fire Debris and Hazard Tree Removal Program is a no direct cost service for property owners who qualify and opt-in.

Property owners must:

#### **OPTION 2 (OPT-OUT):**

**Los Angeles County Local Fire Debris Removal Program** is for property owners who opt-out or do not qualify for Option 1. Property owners must:

Complete and submit a Local Fire Debris Removal Program Application & Work Plan <u>OR</u> Partially Burned or Damaged Structures Application by the *extended* deadline, <u>March 31, 2021</u>. All debris removal must be completed by the *extended* deadline, <u>May 31, 2021</u>.

\* Property owners who fail to submit a (1) ROE OR (2) Local Fire Debris Removal Application & Work Plan or Partially Burned/Damaged Structure Application by the deadline and who do not remove fire debris and hazard trees in an environmentally safe manner may be subject to a summary public nuisance abatement action.
