Additional Disposal Options For...

Used Motor Oil/Used Oil Filters -

Recycle used motor oil/filters at local certified centers (Autozone, Kragens/O'Reillys) or utilize one of County's permanent used oil centers in Altadena, Baldwin Park, Canyon Country, Malibu, Marina Del Rey, Los Angeles, Palmdale, Santa Fe Springs or Sun Valley.

Generated Sharps Waste and Used Medications -

Utilize designated Sheriff's stations for sharps waste disposal, and/or check with your medical provider or city for more disposal options.

Household Batteries - Utilize designated LA County public libraries for household battery disposal, and/or check with local retailers for more disposal options.

Know Your HHW - HHW is any product labeled toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant. E-Waste is any outdated or unwanted electronic device such as a TV, stereo, electronic game, microwave, computer, and a small household appliance.
