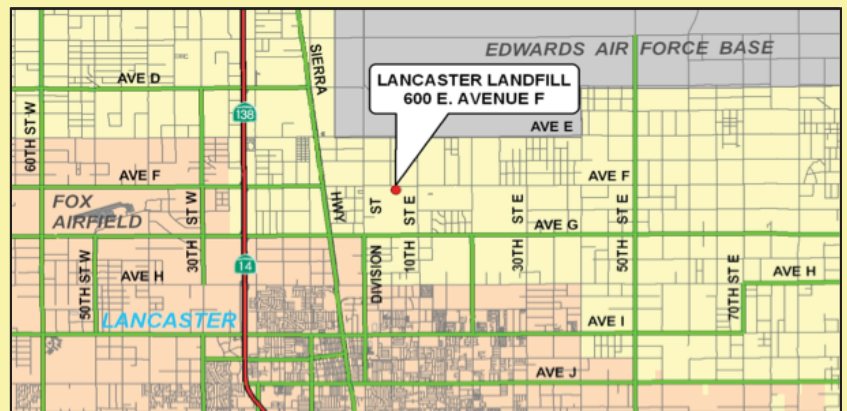


Lancaster Landfill - 600 East Avenue F, Lancaster, CA 93535

Residents of the unincorporated area of Antelope Valley can drop off up to one ton of trash such as furniture, appliances and other bulky items at Lancaster Landfill.

IMPORTANT: Residents must bring proof of residency (e.g., Driver's license). Please tarp down your load to prevent litter.

No business waste, tires or household hazardous waste (paint, cleaning products, etc.) will be accepted. Please wear closed-toe shoes.
