Residents of the unincorporated communities of Castaic and Val Verde can drop off up to one ton of trash such as furniture, appliances and other bulky items at Chiquita Canyon Landfill. Bins will be available to drop off smaller items at the following locations (see enclosed map):

- **Val Verde:** Southwest corner of San Martinez Road and Parker Avenue
- **Castaic:** LA County Public Works, Road Maintenance Division - 526 Yard, 27624 Parker Road, Castaic, CA 91384

COVID-19 Precautions



Do not attend if you have:

- Any COVID-19 symptoms
- Tested positive for COVID-19
- Been asked to quarantine or isolate



Wear a mask if you have:

- Had recent close contact with someone with COVID-19
- Tested positive for COVID-19 but are able to end isolation

IMPORTANT: Residents must bring proof of residency (e.g. Driver's License). Please tarp down your load to prevent litter. No business waste, tires or household hazardous waste (paint, cleaning products, etc.) will be accepted. Please wear closed-toe shoes.
