



## Waste Management, in Partnership with Los Angeles County Supervisor Kathryn Barger, Offers a Complimentary Landfill Visit for the Unincorporated Area Antelope Valley Residents



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Lancaster Landfill and Recycling Center Free Disposal Day events, which typically occur in April and October for residents in the Unincorporated Areas of Antelope Valley, have been canceled for 2020. Social distancing and event restrictions set forth by state and government entities as well as Waste Management policies limited our ability to host these events.

As an alternative, Waste Management is providing an opportunity for residents to recycle and dispose of unwanted materials by offering a one-time **Free Complimentary Landfill Visit** to use October 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. Please see the following for program details.

- Proof of residency required; such as a valid driver's license with current address.
- Available to 600 residents on a first come first serve basis.
- Program ends December 31, 2020 or until all 600 Complimentary Landfill Visits have been processed.
- Valid at Lancaster Landfill and Recycling Center only.
- Limited to one (1) load only.
- Maximum of one (1) ton limit.
- All loads are subject to posted gate rates exceeding one (1) ton.
- No commercial waste accepted; standard rates apply.
- All visitors must pass the scales 15 minutes prior to closing.
- This program is separate from the Illegal Dumping Task Force Landfill Voucher Program.
- Program does not apply to Palmdale and Lancaster City residents.
