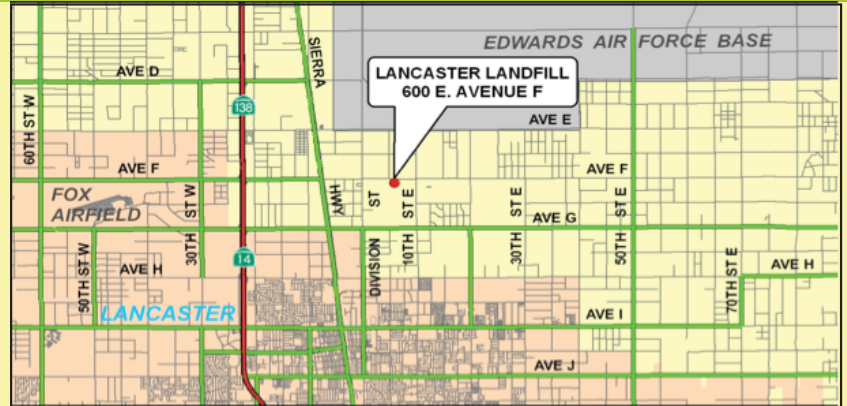


Lancaster Landfill - 600 East Avenue F, Lancaster, CA 93535

Residents in unincorporated Antelope Valley areas can drop off up to one ton of trash, including furniture, appliances, and other bulky items at the Lancaster Landfill.

**IMPORTANT:** Residents must bring proof of residency (e.g., Driver's License). Please tarp down your load to prevent litter.

No business waste, tires, or household hazardous waste (paint, cleaning products, etc) will be accepted. Please wear closed-toe shoes.
