## Reminder! Holiday Tree and Foliage Recycling

Holiday trees/foliage will be collected from December 26, 2024 through January 17, 2025.

### Please remember to:

- Remove all lights, ornaments, tinsel and stands.
- Place trees/foliage at the curb next to your trash receptacle on your regular collection day (do not block streets, alleys or sidewalks).

Plastic trees/foliage are not recycled or accepted. Please call (800) 675-1171 to schedule a bulky item pick-up.

## Excess Trash Pickup

Residential customers can schedule up to four free pickups per year for the items listed below. To arrange a pickup, please place the items at the curb on your next regular pickup day, and call our Customer Service Department at least 24 hours in advance.

- **Bulky Items:** An unlimited number of large items per pickup, such as furniture and appliances.
- **Electronic Waste:** Up to 10 items per pickup.
- **Excess Green Waste:** Maximum of 10 bags/bundles per pickup. Bundles must be bound and less than four feet in length.
- **Excess Trash:** Maximum of five bags or disposable containers per pickup. Loose trash will not be collected.
- **Unwanted Clothing:** An unlimited number of bags of clothing per pickup.
- **Construction Demolition:** Two containers/bundles less than 70 pounds each, per pickup.
