<p>Recycling Dumpster/Cart (Blue Container w/Black Lid/ Blue Cart w/Blue Lid)</p> 	<p>Recyclable Waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flattened Cardboard • Magazines, Newspapers, Junk Mail • Office Paper • Brown Paper Bags • Plastic Bottles • Phone Books • Paperboard • Aluminum Cans, Foil, & Pie Tins • Steel Cans and Empty Aerosol Cans
<p>Organic Waste Dumpster/Cart (Green Container w/Black Lid/ Green Cart w/Green Lid)</p> 	<p>Food Waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Produce (Vegetables, fruits, salads, vegetable trims, and frozen fruits) • Meat/Seafood/Dairy (All cooked and raw meat products including bones and shells. Fish, beef, pork, chicken, turkey, egg shells, nut shells and cheese) • Bakery & Grocery (All types of breads and bakery waste, and excess batter. Post date and spilled items, all dry goods including pasta, beans, flour, rice, cereal, sugar etc.) • Coffee grounds, tea leaves <p>Food Soiled Paper Goods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compostable cups, plates, silverware, cardboard packaging, paper napkins, paper towels, and paper packaging • Coffee filters, tea bags <p>Yard Waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plants & trimmings, lawn clippings, cut flowers, house plants, and flower bouquet • Leaves, grass, weeds, small branches
