RECOMMENDATION FOR ADVISORY PANEL OF SB 1383 (2016) INFRASTRUCTURE AND MARKET ANALYSIS REPORT

The Los Angeles County Solid Waste Management Committee/Integrated Waste Management Task Force (Task Force) appreciates CalRecycle's initiative to work with experienced consultants regarding the development of the organics infrastructure and market analysis and would like to offer recommendations for the preparation of the analysis report. The Task Force is aware that the awarded consultant, Integrated Waste Management Consulting, LLC, proposed to include an advisory panel of stakeholders, including industry experts, for review of the draft analysis report. The Task Force recommends that the advisory panel include representatives from local government. Local governments will be the most impacted by the SB 1383 (2016) requirements and should have their input included in the analysis.

Consistent with these responsibilities and to ensure a coordinated, cost-effective, and environmentally sound solid waste management
