RECOMMENDATION FOR ADVISORY PANEL OF SB 1383 (2016) INFRASTRUCTURE AND MARKET ANALYSIS REPORT

The Los Angeles County Solid Waste Management Committee/Integrated Waste Management Task Force (Task Force) appeciates CalRecycle's initiative to work with experienced consultants regarding the development of the organics infrastructure and market analysis and would like to offer recommendations for the preparation of the analysis report. The Task Force is aware that the awarded consultant, Integrated Waste Management Consulting, LLC, proposed to include an advisory panel of stakeholders, including industry experts, for review of the draft analysis report. The Task Force recommends that the advisory panel include representatives from local government. Local governments will be the most impacted by the SB 1383 (2016) requirements and should have their input included in the analysis.

Pursuant to Chapter 3.67 of the Los Angeles County Code and the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (Assembly Bill 939 [AB 939], as amended), the Task Force is responsible for coordinating the development of all major solid waste planning documents prepared for the County of Los Angeles and the 88 cities in Los Angeles County with a combined population in excess of ten million. Consistent with these responsibilities and to ensure a coordinated, cost-effective, and environmentally sound solid waste management

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system in Los Angeles County, the Task Force also addresses issues impacting the system on a countywide basis. The Task Force membership includes representatives of the League of California Cities-Los Angeles County Division, County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors, City of Los Angeles, the waste management industry, environmental groups, the public, and a number of other governmental agencies. Additionally, please provide a copy of the analysis report when available.

The Task Force respectfully requests that CalRecycle consider the mentioned recommendation and informs the Task Force of the decision and outcome of the advisory panel.
