#### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m.

#### **II. REPORT ON AB 1090 HEARING**

Mr. Skye provided a summary of the AB 1090 proceedings held in the City of Los Angeles on November 16, 2005. According to Mr. Skye, the majority of the speakers at the hearing supported the development of conversion technologies. However, there was limited inaccurate testimony presented by conversion opponents. The Subcommittee unanimously passed a motion recommending the Task Force send a clarification letter to the Assembly Natural Resources Committee (ANRC) responding to these inaccurate claims.

# III. CLARIFICATION OF CRITERIA FOR CSD'S CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING FOR THE PILOT CONVERSION TECHNOLOGY FACILITY

At the October Subcommittee meeting, a motion was passed requesting the Sanitation Districts clarify in writing their official position regarding consideration of funding a "pilot" facility based on the requirements of the CUP for the Puente Hills Landfill. Mr. Wheless reported that he is in the process of drafting a letter, and hopes to have it completed soon. Mr. Alva recommended that the correspondence be forwarded to the Subcommittee, and if meriting discussion, be placed on next month's agenda.

## IV. DISCUSSION OF SCOPES OF WORK FOR THE PUBLIC OUTREACH PLAN AND DEMONSTRATION FACILITY

Minor changes were made to both scopes of work since October's meeting based on comments received by Subcommittee members, and a schedule of deliverables was developed for each. Mr. Theroux commented that the Subcommittee should consider setting up a steering committee or advisory panel in order to enhance outreach efforts for the public outreach plan.
