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#### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 10:10 am.

# II. APPROACH AND CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION OF ADDITIONAL TECHNOLOGY VENDORS

ARI provided the Subcommittee with three options to pursue when considering additional technology vendors for Phase II of the facilitation project, as outlined in a memo dated July 27, 2006.

Discussion ensued related to the consideration of anaerobic digestion, solid waste facility permits, and the processes and criteria that could be used for considering additional technology vendors. Mr. Theroux made a motion that the Subcommittee send a letter to the short list of vendors from Phase I, requesting new information, and advising them that the Subcommittee is interested in their ancillary capabilities for integration in regards to combined heat, power, and fuels. The motion passed.

Mr. Theroux then made a motion to send a letter to the eight technology vendors passing the Phase I screening criteria but not selected as one of the 6 short-listed companies. The letter would solicit new and relevant information as well as request the companies to address the concerns raised in the Phase I report, as appropriate. The motion passed unanimously with Mr. Mohajer abstaining.

Regarding new technology vendors not evaluated in Phase I, Mr. Theroux made a motion that the Subcommittee defer deliberation on this issue until responses are received from the two motions above. The motion passed unanimously with Mr. Mohajer abstaining.

#### III. UPDATE ON PUBLIC OUTREACH CONTRACT

The RFP for the Public Outreach Contract is expected to be released in early August. Mr. Skye requested contact information from the Subcommittee for companies they knew of that may be interested in responding to the RFP.
