Commissioner Estey and Watkins inquired whether there is anyone monitoring the crossing guards to make sure they are showing up at the locations and whether or not they are conducting their crossing guard duties correctly. Mr. James Chon informed the HSC that the LACOE is in charge of the contract administration of the crossing guards and if Public Works receives any citizen or parent complaints, these complaints are forwarded to both the LACOE and the actual crossing guard company providing the service.
