AV IRWMP First Stakeholder Meeting Wednesday, April 18, 2012

The first Antelope Valley Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) 2007 Update Stakeholder meeting was held on April 18, 2012, at Palmdale Water District, 2029 E. Avenue Q, Palmdale, CA 93550. Attendees are listed in the attached sign-in sheet.

1. Welcome and Introductions

- a. The meeting was opened by Dave Rydman (WWD), led by Brian Dietrick (RMC), and called to order at 9:10am.
- b. Handouts of the meeting agenda were distributed. An electronic copy of the presentation is attached.

2. Meeting Objectives

a. Brian explained the meeting objectives. These included: introduce the IRWMP Team, review Antelope Valley progress to date, discuss key objectives moving forward, lay out schedule to meet grant deadlines, discuss Stakeholder participation, and discuss role of committees.

3. The IRWMP Team

a. Brian described the AV IRWMP team for the plan update.

4. Antelope Valley Progress to Date

a. Brian presented a quick AV IRWMP Progress update, starting from the first AV IRWMP Plan in 2007 to the recent grant wins (Prop 1E, Prop 84 Planning, and Prop 84 implementation).

Key Objectives Moving Forward

- a. Brian discussed the key objectives moving forward in updating the AV IRWMP, which included the following:

 - 1. Compiling updated info & address gaps
 - 2. Facilitating stakeholder discussions

 - ii. Address key planning issues for the Region, which include:
 - 1. Disadvantaged Communities (DAC) outreach
 - 2. S/N Management Plan
 - Integrated flood management (Brian commented that more information/data from stakeholders is needed for the Kern/Palmdale/Lancaster regions)
 - 4. Climate Change

- iii. Prepare for future grant opportunities such as:
 - 1. Prop 84 Round 2 Implementation grant
 - 2. Local GW Assistance grant
 - 3. USBR WaterSmart grants

6. Schedule to Meet Funding Deadlines

- a. Brian went through the project schedule
 - Project schedule has been adjusted to start later and end earlier (as compared to the original schedule in the RMC proposal) in order to meet grant funding deadlines

 - 2. Need a consistent climate change understanding for the region, which is mainly a water supply story. The region needs to address how changes in climate (i.e., increase in temperature) will affect reliability of imported water.
- b. Budget: Stakeholders wanted to know status on project budget and receive assurance the AV IRWMP update will not go over budget. RMC is committed to completing the project within the established budget.




