4. Status of RFQ Process

Peter Massey (TreePeople) updated the Committee; applications have been processed, they have found a good set of applicants that they would like to move forward with. They are extending the deadline through January to conduct targeted outreach to identify NGOs to fill the gaps that are not set to be addressed by the current tentative recommendations. Those recommendations will be brought to the GLAC DAC Committee for concurrence. They also have a full slate of Leadership Committee candidates that they will also be bringing to the DAC Committee meeting. 107 identified communities there are still about 60 that we are trying to reach. TreePeople is working on compiling a map that will also be presented to the Committee to show which areas have and have-not been identified as having adequate representation from the NGOs.

5. Chair Position Update

Virginia gave an update on the Chair position; LACFCD has not received a definitive response regarding the position, a suggestion was made for a rotational chair position until there is a decision on the newly appointed Chair. Randy said it would be a good option if someone is able to volunteer for it. Virginia reminded the Committee that LACFCD will continue to work closely with the Committee and the Chair to facilitate the meetings. Randy supports the suggestion as it is imperative to fill the position.
