The Harbor-UCLA Replacement Program is a \$1.7 billion investment to improve access and equity to underserved communities and expand healthcare capabilities for the only Level I Trauma Center in south Los Angeles County.

The 7-story Parking Structure adds more than 1,500 new parking stalls to the Harbor-UCLA Medical Center Campus, including infrastructure to support more than 350 Electric Vehicle Stalls. The new Parking Structure will be centrally located to ensure that patients, families, and staff will have convenient access to the new facilities on campus.

The new structure is located on Meyler Street north of 220th Street; see map on the second page of this notice for more information.

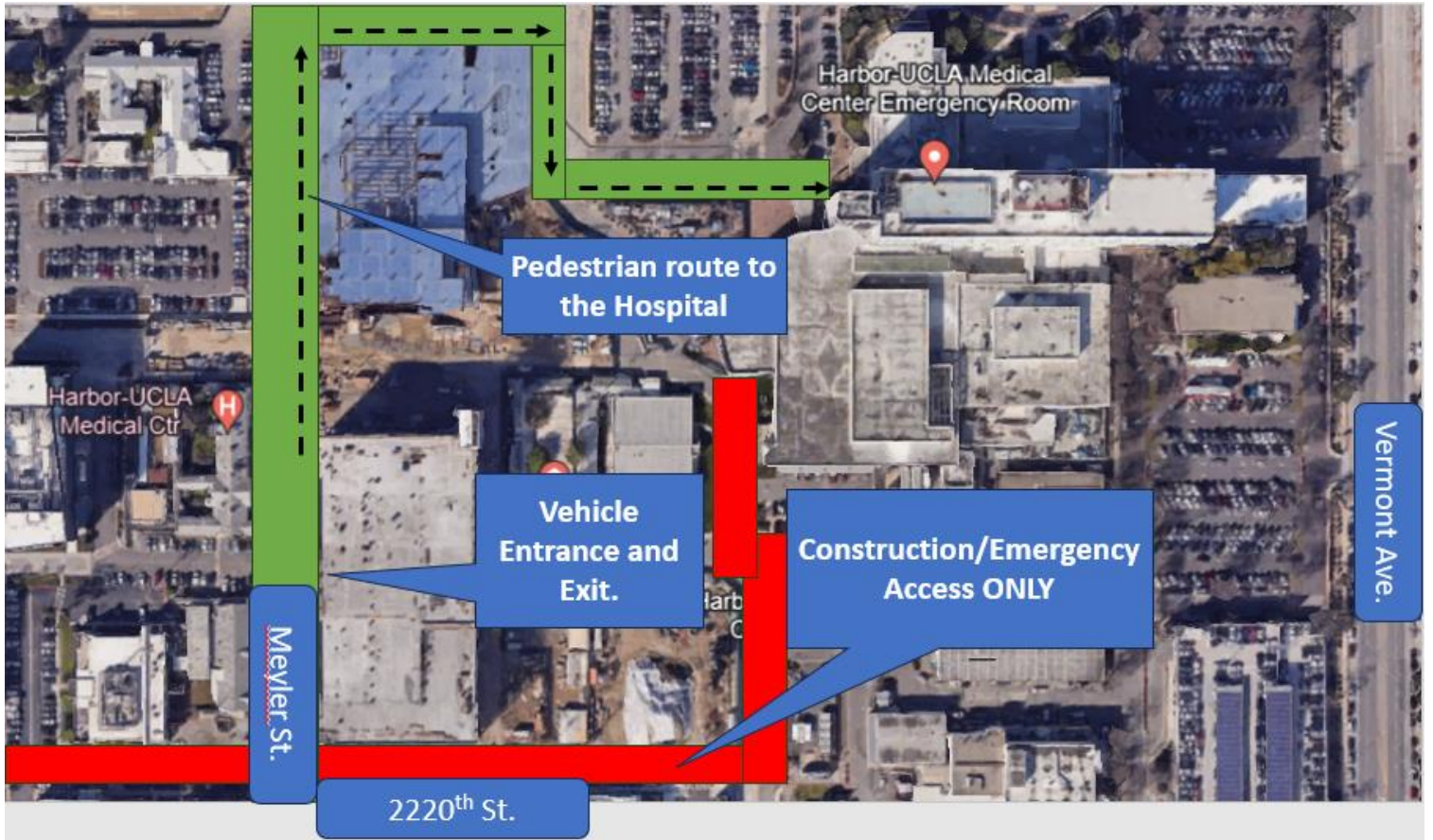
