White (Live) oak, marked but not fallen. Bearing trees as called for in Patent and by Reynolds. Still exist.  
 Small mound of stones. Found part of old stone underneath. Consider it Hancock's original corner.

Point located from Patent bearing-trees which are still standing.

Point on West side of dry gully. One of Reynolds bearing-trees still standing.

White oak tree blazed but no marks nor visible on East side of Canada de Los Colorado. 3" diameter as called for in Patent and used by Reynolds as corner.

Live oak tree marked "S.F. 40" used by Reynolds and a tree's well with course and distance of Patent from Sta. 39  
 Small mound of rocks on N.H. slope of mountain to the South as called for in Patent.

Old stone marked "S.F. 42" at Hancock's station in 5142 and "S.F. 43" in mound of rocks on N.H. slope of mountain. Original corner as per Patent and also Reynolds' survey.
