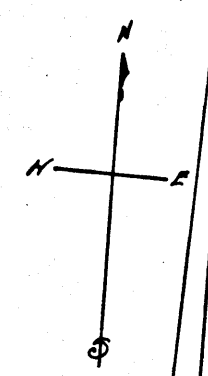


Plat of

Reynolds transit line

D. 152-39

Row of stumps along W. bank of ballade (ditch) which Reynolds and Wright claimed was the patent boundary. This claim was abandoned after the decree established the line as being along the live willow fence to the East. (See C.F. 155 and C.S. 8107).

This deed was cancelled by the decree and the line between the live willow fence and the row of stumps along the ballade was declared to be a part of Bouchard Tract.
