The Zones within said District and the percentage of the sum to be raised from each zone for expenses of acquiring, opening and improvement proposed; all in accordance with the provisions of the "Acquisition and Improvement Act of 1925" approved May 23, 1925, commonly known as the "Mattoon Act."

Assessment District to be known as "Acquisition and Improvement District No. 'M-1' of the City of Maywood."

### SHOWING

1. Property to be acquired - Cross-hatched in red.
2. "A" Zone - Shaded in red, from which shall be raised 50% of total costs.
3. Assessment District - Bounded in green.
4. Proposed Clarkson Avenue.
5. "B" Zone - All unshaded area within green boundary, from which shall be raised 50% of total costs.
