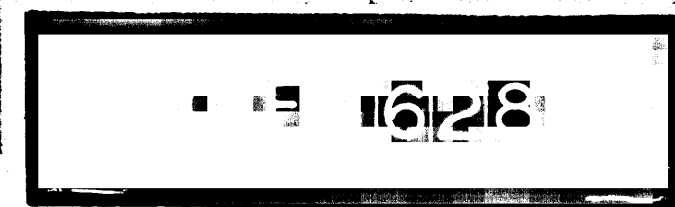


MAP
