Set spike, washer & tin in center of trunk of old burnt stump which is the same as located by Geo. W. Jones and it has the original markings - See Road Dept. F.B. 115-40. Note: This stump was accepted by J.E. Rockhold County Surveyor of Los Angeles County and Chas. W. Pett County Surveyor of Ventura County as being the stump of the marked oak tree "S B" referred to by E.T. Wright and J.T. Stow in their report of Survey of the Dividing Line between Los Angeles and Ventura Counties made in 1881, and established by them on said survey as an angle point in said dividing line. See R.F. Map No 583 and M.R. 43-25 - Records of Los Angeles County. CS. 61-130.

On Oct 6, 1921 Set 2" Iron Pipe in Concrete Monument to replace Spike, Washer & Tin. The 2" Iron Pipe has a Brass Cap marked thus - Left a part of the Old Oak Tree standing. C.S.F.B. 61-130.
