

L Friel being duly sworn deposes and says he is the person employed as engineer to make the survey by Samuel Merrill, the owner and claimant of the reservoir referred to and shown on the map on which this is inscribed, that the survey of the said dammed reservoir described as follows: (circuitously and privately) beginning at a point station 1 in the station of Rancho Tejunga in T2N R14W S.B.M. bears S 54° 11' 32" E 3253 feet, an area on private land of 62.9 acres, an area of unsurveyed land of 211.08 acres was made by him as surveyor and engineer for said Samuel Merrill under his authority, commencing on the 31st day of August 1895 and ending on the 4th day of September 1895 and that the survey of the said reservoir accurately represents a line which is the proposed water line of the said reservoir and that such survey is accurately represented upon the map and by the accompanying field notes and no lake bed, stream or stream bed is used for the said reservoir as shown on the map.

I, Samuel Merrill do hereby certify that I am the owner and claimant of the reservoir set forth and shown in the map on which this is inscribed, that L Friel who subscribed the accompanying affidavit is the engineer employed by me or me the survey, that the survey of the said reservoir is accurately represented on this map and by the accompanying field notes was made under my authority; that the said reservoir is represented on this map and by the said field notes now adopted by me on the 3rd day of January 1896 as the definite location of the said reservoir and described as follows: on unsurveyed and private land, beginning at station 1, in the station of Rancho Tejunga in T2N R14W S.B.M. bears S 52° 54' W 3253 feet, an area on private land of 62.9 acres, and an area on unsurveyed land of 211.08 acres, and that no lake or lake bed or stream or stream bed is used for the said reservoir except as shown on this map, and that the map has been prepared to be filed for the approval of the Secretary of the Interior in order that I may obtain the desired protection to the public lands and for other purposes.
