Dear Sir:-

In making a Survey of a portion of the E. N. E. S. E. Sec. 11, T. 1 S., R. 10 W., S. B. B. & M., I procured such Ties as were to be found on the records in your Office, the Highway Commissioners Office and the City Engineer of Covina.

A number of those given are not now to be found, and for such as are identifiable my sources of information appear to be at variance; also, the new pavement on Citrus Avenue covers up the Granite Stone and Iron Pipe at the intersections of Cypress and Cienega Avenues respectively, so that they are not easily accessible even if allowed to remain in place when the pavement was laid.

I therefore drove spikes at the various points along the center line of Citrus Avenue, and installed new tie points where necessary, and submit this report thereof together with the accompanying Plat of the Survey for such use and service as may be acceptable to your Office.

In this connection I also found an apparent error in the platting of TRACT NO. 1022, (M. B. 17 - 45), in that L. M. Butler's Deed (BOOK of DEEDS, 3077 - page 53) specifies Nine and Three-fourths Acres. The said Tract is therefore extended 11.58 ft. too far North.
