Field Notes of the final survey of the Rancho Anita by Henry Hancock
Instructions of May 17, 1858.
Confirmed to Henry Dalton.

- S. $62\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 5.50 Across stream of water 8 links wide course SE.
21.08 to Sta. No. 13 on W. side of stream of water 8 lks. wide,
course SE. and marked a Black Oak 13 ins. dia. Thence
- N. $18^{\circ} 24'$ E. .40 Cross last named Stream.
13.00 Cross road course SE.
21.00 Cross stream of water 6 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.
329.00 Into ravine some 100 ft. deep course SE.
340.78 To Sta. No. 14 and set post for NW. corner of the
ranch from which
A live oak 20 ins. dia. bears N. 88° E. dist. 104 lks.
Thence
- S. 22° E. 61.00 Leave dry arroyo course SW. 20 chs. wide.
66.02 To Sta. No. 15 set post and charred stake from which
A live oak 14 ins. dia. bears N. 82° E. dist. 125 lks.
A sycamore 14 ins. dia. N. 78° W. 221 lks. dist.
Thence
- N. $84\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 47.55 Intersected the 11th Range Line west of the San
Bernardino Meridian 30.54 chs. S. of secs. 7, 18,
12 and 13, and set post and charred stake at the
point of intersection.
65.00 Enter Canada course SW.
92.00 Leave same.
98.00 Cross dry arroyo course S.
102.25 To Sta. No. 16, at S. base of mountain and drove stake
and charred stake. Thence
- S. 62° E. 91.00 To Sta. No. 17 and drove stake and charred stake.
Thence
- EAST 36.00 Across mountain road course SW.
67.00 Cross dry arroyo, 2 chs. wide course SE.
145.38 To Sta. No. 18 on east side of dry arroyo 3 chs.
wide course SW. Set stake and charred stake.
Thence
- S 21° W. 68.50 To Sta. No. 19 drove stake and charred stake.
Thence
- S 32° E. 5.50 To Sta. No. 20 at S. point of spur from mountain
and set stake.
Thence
- EAST 56.68 To Sta. No. 21 and set stake.
Thence
- N. 65° E. 102.00 To Sta. No. 22 and drove stake and charred stake
on W. bank of a canada, course SE.
Thence
- S. 66° E. 28.00 Across small stream of water 5 chs. wide course SW.
28.50 To Sta. No. 1 or place of beginning.
