NORTH between Sections 14 and 15.

Var. 14°25' E.

50.00 The corner of old survey having been destroyed by S.P.R.R., set post 4 ins. sq. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4½ ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high at one of the posts in board fence of S.P.R.R. 6 lks. (Douglass copy has 61 lks.) W. for witness post to corner to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15.  
Land mountainous except in valley.  
Soil 1st. and 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak and Sycamore.

Var. 14°25' E.

NORTH between Sections 10 and 11.

Counting from true corner I ascend.  
32.00 Cross Canada bears SE. and ascend.  
33.00 Summit of spur brs. E & W. and descend.  
40.00 The old ¼ sec. corner a Cedar post in large mound of rocks on N. slope of spur.  
42.25 Cross gulch 13 lks. wide course SE and ascend.  
48.00 Cross copper lode brs. NE & SE (Douglass copy SW), considerable work has been done in former years on this lode but now is abandoned.  
50.00 Falling on steep side of short rocky ridge, not a suitable place to build a mound I set post 4 ins. sq. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4½ ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. high 57 lks. N. of top of ridge for witness post to corner to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11.  
Land mountainous. Soil 2nd and 3rd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine and Oak.

NORTH between Sections 21 and 22.

Var. 14°25' E.

50.00 The point for corner to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, falling on steep side hill, not a suitable place to build mound set post 4 ins. sq. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4½ ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high 82 lks. S. of (Douglass copy "on") top of spur bearing NW & SE, witness post to said corner.  
Land mountainous. Soil 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of pine, oak and bunchgrass.

NORTH between Sections 15 and 16.

Var. 14°25' E.

(Descend - Douglass)  
20.75 Cross gulch 12 lks. wide course NW (and ascend - Douglass).  
27.00 Summit of spur brs. NW & SE. and descend.  
39.70 The ¼ section corner as established in former survey which I find standing on the N. slope of ridge. A cedar post in stone mound as per description furnished me.  
64.50 Cross fence brs. E & W. and in Soledad Canada.  
65.06 Cross ditch brs. E & W.  
73.95 Cross fence brs. E & W.  
74.73 Center of S.P.R.R. track brs. E & W.  
79.34 Cross wagon road brs. E & W.  
80.00 To the SW. corner of J.H. Whitney's house, all traces of the corner have been destroyed by the building, I marked the corner and drive an iron bolt ½ in. dia. in ground for corner to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16.  
Land mountainous. Soil 1st and 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Oak, Cedar and Cottonwood.

EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 10 and 15.

Var. 14°25' E.

Thru City of Ravenna.  
36.50 Cross wagon road enter field and leave Ravenna.  
40.00 After diligent search being unable to find old ¼ section corner I set temporary one.  
65.50 Leave fields and cross wagon road brs. SE & NW.

- 70.00 Leave low bottom land and enter table land.  
 80.00 Intersect the N & S. line 42 lks. S. of corner, I run  
 S. 89°42' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 10 and 15.  
 Var. 14°25' E.
- 40.00 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth mound 4 ft.  
 dia. at base by 2 ft. high and dug pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. 8 lks.  
 N. for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner.
- 80.00 The corner to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16.  
 Land rolling. Soil 1st and 2nd rate.  
 Timber and undergrowth of Cottonwood; Cedar and Willow.  
 - - - - - Jan. 22, 1880 (Douglass)
- NORTH between Sections 9 and 10. Var. 14°25' E.
- From SW corner of Whitney's house I offset W. 50 lks. to avoid wing of  
 house and ascend steep mountain.
- 40.00 I offset back E. 50 lks. the post for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner falling on  
 large boulder I set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth and 1 ft. above  
 stone mound 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high 170 lks. N. for wit-  
 ness post to  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.
- 50.00 Summit of spur brs. NE & SW. and descend.  
 50.25 A large boulder on line (of descent - Douglass notes).  
 57.00 Cross gulch 14 lks. wide course SW.  
 79.50 Cross gulch 12 lks. wide course SW.  
 80.00 Set post 4 ins. sq. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
 dia. at base by 2 ft. high for corner to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10.  
 Land mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. (Timber and undergrowth of pine,  
 oak and cedar - Douglass notes)

- EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 3 and 10.  
 (Ascend - Douglass notes) Var. 14°25' E.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner.  
 60.00 Summit of spur brs. NW & SE.  
 65.50 Leave spur and descend.  
 80.26 Intersect the N & S. line 37 lks. N. of the corner to Sections 2, 3,  
 10 and 11. From which corner I run  
 N. 89°44' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 3 and 10.  
 Var. 14°25' E.
- 40.13 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft.  
 dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner.  
 80.26 To corner to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10.  
 Land mountainous. Soil 2nd rate.  
 Timber and undergrowth of Oak and Cedar.  
 - - - - -
- NORTH between Sections 20 and 21. Var. 14°25' E.
- 80.00 Set stone 10 x 12 x 6 ins. 7 ins. in the ground for corner to  
 Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21.  
 Land mountainous. Soil 1st and 2nd rate.  
 Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak, Cedar and Cottonwood.  
 - - - - -
- NORTH between Sections 16 and 17. Var. 14°25' E.  
 (Ascend - Douglass notes)
- 40.00 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft.  
 dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.  
 55.50 Summit of spur brs. NE & SW. and descend.  
 78.50 Summit of spur brs. NW & SE.  
 80.00 The post corner to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, falling on steep side  
 hill, not a suitable place to build mound I marked a Cedar tree  
 6 ins. dia. on top of knoll 100 lks. West for witness to said corner.  
 Soil 2nd rate. (Land mountainous - Douglass notes).  
 Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak and Cedar.  
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EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 9 and 16.  
(Descend - Douglass notes) Var. 14°25' E.

- 3.50 Cross gulch 15 lks. wide course NW. and ascend.
- 16.00 Summit of spur brs. NW & SE.
- 25.20 I find old stake marked appropriately as called for in former survey on the ground about 30 lks. SW. but no indication of a mound, so I continue.
- 26.00 Leave mountain and enter canada. (Brs. NE & SE - Douglass notes).
- 29.25 Cross road brs. NW & SE.
- 38.10 Cross creek 6 lks. wide course NW.
- 40.00 The old  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner having been destroyed by S.P.R.R. I set temporary one on N. side of R.R.
- 47.50 Cross S.P.R.R. track between tank house and depot.
- 56.00 James O'Reilly's store about 3 chs. N.
- 56.50 Cross road brs. NE & SW. and enter field.
- 74.00 Leave field and cross road NE & SW.
- 80.00 Intersect the N & S. line 27 lks. S. of corner to 9, 10, 16 and 15. From which corner I run

S. 59°45' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 9 and 16.  
Var. 14°25' E.

- 40.00 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.
- 80.00 The corner to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17.  
Land mountainous except in valley. Soil 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak and Willow.

NORTH between Sections 8 and 9. Var. 14°25' E.  
(Descend - Douglass notes).

- 3.00 (Leave mountain and enter - Douglass notes) Enter valley of Santa Clara at mouth of canada brs. E & W.
- 6.00 Cross road in dry bed of Santa Clara brs. E & W.
- 7.25 Cross S.P.R.R. track brs. E & W.  
Antone Buelas claim W. of line.  
His house about 25 chs. W.
- 12.00 Leave canada 2.50 chs. wide and ascend.
- 22.50 Summit of spur brs. NE & SW. and descend.
- 39.50 Cross gulch 12 lks. wide course SE.
- 40.00 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.
- 44.50 Cross same gulch 12 lks. wide course SW. and ascend.
- 62.00 Summit of spur brs. NE & SW. and descend.
- 79.75 Cross gulch 14 lks. wide course W.
- 80.00 Set post 4 ins. sq. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for corner to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9.  
Land mountainous. Soil 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Cedar, Oak and Bunchgrass.

EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 4 and 9.  
(Ascend - Douglass notes) Var. 14°25' E.

- 18.00 Summit of spur brs. NW & SE. and descend.
- 31.00 Cross dry gulch 15 lks. wide course SW. and ascend.
- 40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner.
- 61.00 Summit of spur brs. NE & SW. and descend.
- 79.68 Intersect the N & S. line 52 lks. S. of corner to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10. From which corner I run

S. 59°35' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 4 and 9.  
Var. 14°25' E.

- 39.84 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.
- 79.68 The corner to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land mountainous. Soil 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak and Cedar.

NORTH between Sections 17 and 18. Var. 14°25' E.

50.00 The point for corner to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18 falling on edge of wagon road I set iron spike or bolt  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. dia. and 8 ins. long at the point and at 84 lks. W. I set a post 4 ins. sq., 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for witness post to said corner. From which brs. a  
Live Oak 30 ins. dia. N. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 54 lks.  
Live Oak 35 ins. dia. S. 79° W. 148 lks.  
This corner is on the S. side of Santa Clara Valley at foot of mt. Soil 2nd rate. Timber and undergrowth of Oak and Cedar.  
(Land mountainous - Douglass notes)

EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 8 and 17. Var. 14°25' E.

Along South side of Santa Clara Valley.  
23.00 Cross road brs. NE & SW.  
23.50 Cross mouth of gulch brs. N.  
34.00 Leave valley and ascend.  
40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.  
50.20 Intersect the N & S. line 42 lks. E. of corner to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17. From which corner I run

S. 89°42' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 8 and 17. Var. 14°25' E.

40.10 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner. From which bears an  
Oak 48 ins. dia. N. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 188 lks,  
Antone Buelas house brs. NE. about 12 chs. dist.  
50.20 The corner to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18.  
Land mountainous except in valley. Soil 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak and Willow.  
----- Jan. 27, 1880 (Douglass notes)

NORTH between Sections 7 and 8. Var. 14°25' E.

50.00 Set post 4 ins. sq., 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone mound  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for corner to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8.  
This corner is on summit of spur bearing NW & SE.  
Land mountainous. Soil 1st and 2nd rate.  
Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak, Cedar and Bunchgrass.

EAST on a RANDOM line between Sections 5 and 8. Var. 14°25' E.

1.50 Descend steep mountain.  
20.25 Cross gulch 18 lks. wide course SE. and ascend.  
32.50 Summit of spur brs. SE & NW. and descend.  
40.00 Set temporarily  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.  
42.30 Cross gulch 22 lks. wide course S. and ascend.  
59.50 Summit of spur brs. SW & NE.  
79.86 Intersect the N & S. line 43 lks. S. of cor. to Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  
From which corner I run

S. 89°42' W. on a TRUE line between Sections 5 and 8. Var. 14°25' E.

39.93 Set post 4 ins. dia. 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above stone md. 4 ft. dia. at base by 2 ft. high for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
79.86 To cor. to Secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.  
Land mountainous. Soil 2nd rate. Timber and undergrowth of Pine, Oak, Cedar and Bunchgrass.
