From this point I run West

West on south line of section 13

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{2}$ mile post with mound, corner to sections 13, 14, 23 & 24.
Land second rate, open and hilly.

On south line of section 14.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post with mound.

65.00 To valley.

80.00 Set post with mound, corner to sections 14, 15, 22
and 23.

Second rate land and hilly.

South line of section 15

2.00 Cross road to Cajon de Las Rivas, course north of west.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post with mound.

80.00 Set post with mound corner to sections 15, 16, 21
and 22 at foot of hill.

Second rate land and rolling.

South line of section 16

Over hills.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post with mound.

65.00 To valley extending more than one mile south

80.00 Set post with mound, corner to sections 16, 17, 20
and 21.

Land good second rate.

North on west line of section 16.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post on road to Cajon Des Rivas, course
east and west on south bank of small lake. Make mound
and run west through section 17.

West inside section 17.

4.00 Pass west end of lake.

31.50 Cross trail to San Francisco Rancho, course south.

50.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post on west line of section 17 and
make mound.

Land second rate.

50.00 Set a post charred & chalked & notched for the corner
to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24 & raised a mound with trench
& pits as per instructions.

Land hilly & 2nd rate.

South between sec. 14 & 15.

Var. 14° 13' E.

50.00 Set a post charred, chalked & notched for the corner
to secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23 & raised a mound with trench
& pits as per instructions.

Land 2nd rate & very hilly.

East on a random line between secs. 14 & 23.

Var. 14° 13' E.

40.00 Set a post for temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner.

79.56 Intersect N. & S. line 50 lks. N. of the corner to
secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, from which corner I run

West on a true line between sec. 14 & 23.

Var. 13° 52' E.

39.75 Set a post charred & chalked for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner &
raised a mound with trench & pits as per instructions

T. 8 N., R. 18 W. of the San Bernardino Meridian

- 79.56 The corner to sec. 14, 15, 22 & 23.
Land hilly & good 2nd rate.

South between sec. 22 & 23.
Var. 14° 13' E.
- 3.50 Cross road to Fort Tejon course N. 80° W.
- 40.00 Set a post charred & chalked for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner
& raised a mound with trench & pits as per instructions.
This post is on the base of mountain and it is impossible to survey further south as the mountains are very steep and rough.

South between sec. 15 & 16.
Var. 14° 13' East

- 80.00 Set a post, charred, chalked & notched for the corner
to sec. 15, 16, 21 & 22; raised mound with trench &
pits per instns.
Land 2nd rate and very mountainous.
Pine, white and live oak.

East on a random line between sec. 15 & 22.
Var. 14° 13' East
- 40.00 Set a post for temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner
- 68.50 Cross road to Fort Tejon course N. 80° W.
- 79.50 Intersect N. & S. line 47 lks. N. of the corner to
secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23, from which corner I run

West on a true line between sec. 15 & 22.
Var. 13° 53' East
- 39.75 Set a post charred, chalked for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner
& raised a mound with trench & pits per instns.
- 79.50 The corner to sec. 15, 16, 21 & 22.
Land level & good 2nd rate.

South between secs. 21 & 22.

Var. 14° 13' East

40.00 Set a post charred & chalked for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner
& raised a mound with trench & pits per instructions.

65.00 To hills.

80.00 Set a post charred, chalked & notched for the corner
to sec. 21, 22, 27 & 28, & raise mound with trench
pits & c. per instructions.

This corner is at the base of mountains and I can not
survey any more in this Township.

Being unable to find any trace of old corner to sections
22, 23, 26, 27 in order to reestablish same I begin at
corner to sections 14, 15, 22, 23, which I find standing
and agreeing with field notes, and run South on a true
line between sections 22 and 23.

Variation 14° 30' East

Through valley.

12.00 Cross road, bears E. and W.

40.00 Being unable after diligent search to find old corner
I set post 4 in. diameter, 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above
earth mound, 4 ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. in height
and dug pit 24 x 18 x 12, 8 lks. East for $\frac{1}{4}$ section
corner leave valley bears E. and SW. and ascend gradually.

70.00 Top of mountain, bears E. & SW. and descend.

80.00 Set post 4 in. square, 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth
mound, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in diameter at base by 2 ft. in height and
dug pits 24 x 18 x 12, 8 links distant, at 4 angles, for
corner to sections 22, 23, 26, 37.

Land mountainous.

Soil 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber and undergrowth of oak, bunchgrass and chaparral.

Being unable after diligent search to find any trace of corner to sections 21, 22, 27 & 28 in order to reestablish same, I go to corner to sections 15, 16, 21, 22 which I find standing and agreeing with field notes and run South on a true line between sections 21 and 22.

Variation 14° 25' East

Descend.

40.00 Being unable after diligent search to find old corner I set post 4 in. dia., 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth mound, 4 ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. in height and dug pit 24 x 18 x 12, 8 links East for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner.

44.50 Cross gulch, 10 lks. wide, course SW. and ascend.

51.00 Cross road, bears NE. and SW.

80.00 Set post 4 in. square, 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth mound, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. in height and dug pits 24x 18 x 12, 8 lks. dist. at 4 angles for corner to sections 21, 22, 27, 28.

Land mountainous.

Soil 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber and undergrowth of Oak, Chaparral and Bunchgrass

Being unable after diligent search to find any traces of old corner to sections 20, 21, 28, 29, in order to reestablish same, I go to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between sections 20 and 21, which I find standing and agreeing with field notes, and run South between sections 20 and 21.

Va. 14° 30' East

Ascend.

20.25 Summit of ridge bears E. and W. and descend.

- 26.00 Enter valley, bears E. and W.
- 33.75 Cross wash, 15 lks. wide, course E.
- 40.00 Set post 4 in. square, 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth mound, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. in height and dug pits 24 x 18 x 12, 8 lks. dist. at 4 angles for corner to sections 20, 21, 28, 29, from which bears a White Oak 20 ins. dia. S. 14° W. 40 lks. dist.
- Land mountainous.
- Soil 1st and 2nd rate.
- Timber and undergrowth of oak, chaparral and bunchgrass
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- From the corner to sections 17, 18, 19, 20, which I find standing and agreeing with field notes I run West on a random line between sections 18 - 19
- Va. 14° 30' East
- Ascend.
- 40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 62.50 Top of spur, bears NW. and S.E. and descend.
- 80.27 Intersect West boundary of Tp. 15 lks. North of corner to sections 18, 19, 13, 24, from which corner I run N. 89° 54' E. on a true line between sections 18 - 19
- Va. 14° 30' East
- 40.27 Set post 4 in. dia., 1 ft. in earth, 1 ft. above earth mound, 4 ft. in dia. at base by 2 ft. in height and dug pit 24 x 18 x 12, 8 lks. North for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 80.27 The corner to sections 17, 18, 19, 20.
- Land mountainous.
- Soil 1st and 2nd rate.
- Timber and undergrowth of oak and bunchgrass.

South 19' East on a true line on east boundary of
section 13

80.00 Set post 4 inches square, 1 foot in earth, 1 foot above
earth mound, 4½ feet in diameter at base by 2 feet in
height and dug pits 24 x 18 x 12, 8 links distant at 4
angles for corner to sections 18, 19, 13, 24.

Land mountainous.

Soil second rate.

Pine, oak and bunch grass.

South 19' east on east boundary of section 24.

Variation 14° 25' East

Descend.

40.00 Set post 4 inches diameter, 1 foot in earth, 1 foot
above stone mound, 4 feet in diameter at base by 2
feet in height for quarter section corner.

80.00 Set post 4 inches square, 1 foot in earth, 1 foot
above earth mound, 4½ feet in diameter at base by
2 feet in height and dug pits 24 x 18 x 12, 8 links
distant at 4 angles for corner to sections 24, 25, 19, 30.

Land mountainous.

Soil third rate.

Timber and undergrowth of pine, oak and bunchgrass.
