

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The land of these townships is generally undulating, and for the most part apparently well adapted to the cultivation of wheat and small grain, and is entirely free from the fogs of the sea. In the Fractional Townships along the Borthern base of the Mountain, there are some hills and the soil is in some parts rocky. The soil of the majority of the Townships alternates with a red mound, and a reddish sandy leam, and appears for the most part to be second rate. The timber consists of Cottonwood, Elder and Willow, along the streams and on the base of the mountains Cedar, which in Ranges 4.5 A 6 % extends into the plain or valley from two to four miles. The Spanish Bayonet or Palmetto is found scattered in all parts. Underbrush and shrubbery abound in every part, consisting principally of the Reronia, a rosin bush and species of the Chemisal, together with Chemisal of which horses and sheep are very fond.

Bunch grass abounds in all parts and in some portions there are pin and other grasses. The ravines and camons on the Morth face of the mountain, from Range 1 to Range 12 %.

are generally well supplied with Pine timber, which in many parts is of easy access. Permanent water is found along the whole Morthern base of the mountain in distances from two to six miles and it is believed that water may be obtained in almost all parts at a reasonable distance by digging wells.

The bottom lands of the river Mehave is on an average about 60 chs. wide, and in Township 4 N. R. 4 W. the soil is principally first rate; and the swampy portion can be drained by a very trivial amount of labor. In Township 4 N. Ranges 3 & 4 W. the soil of the bottom land is generally sandy and during the summer season the bed of the river is dry. In the Southern portion of Township 3 N. R. 4 W. there is a fine detached valley on the West fork of the Mohave river affording an abundance of feed and having several sections of areable land. The Mohave overflows all of its bottom land to the depth of 3 or 4 feet at times. The river Rio del blano when high, sweeps over from two to four miles in width in its way, Morthwardly through the Valley, rendering a large tract of land stoney and unfit for cultivation, but the river may easily be taken out, either East or West onto other lands for irrigation purposes—for it seems to have by its deposites, raised its bed above the surrounding land. Local attraction prevails in some parts, but throughout this region both in Summer and Winter, I discover a controlling influence over the needle, which I believe has been heretofere unknown to science. First I found that when the instrument was level the needle by the N. or S. end attach itself to the glass (which was always sufficiently well raised) and that the only way I could devise to free it was to wet the glass immediately above the point of contact or adhesion, in which case the needle would repel and detach itself. Again the needle will often settle from 1° to 5° either E. or N. of natural objects I may have in my sight as general guides (to quard against attraction) and that by drawing my wet finger on the glass directly over the needle its whole length, the needle will assume the magnetic Borth; other means seem altogether ineffectual. In some parts I find it unsafe to rely on the course, without first having wet the glass over the needle for its entire length.
