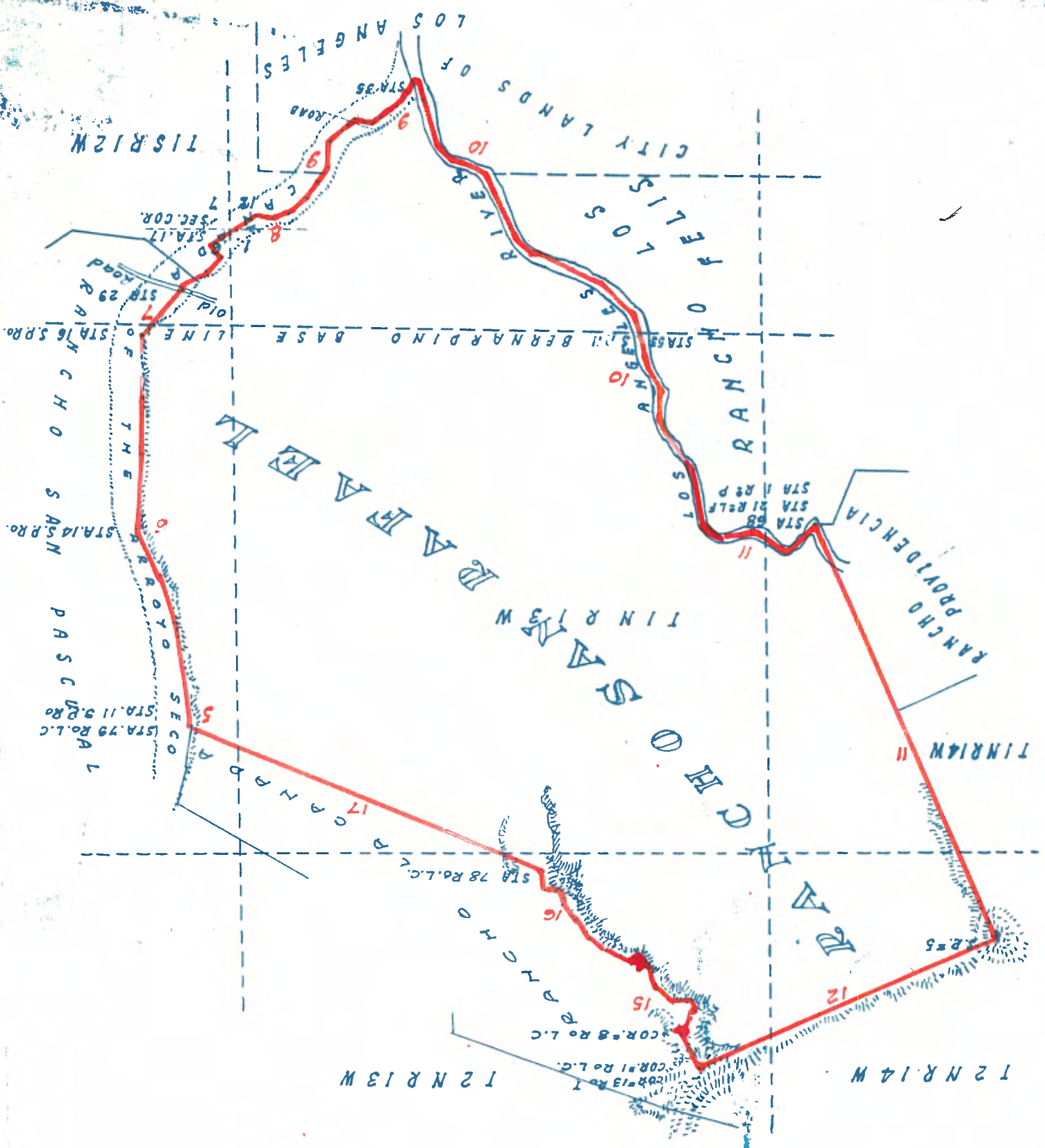

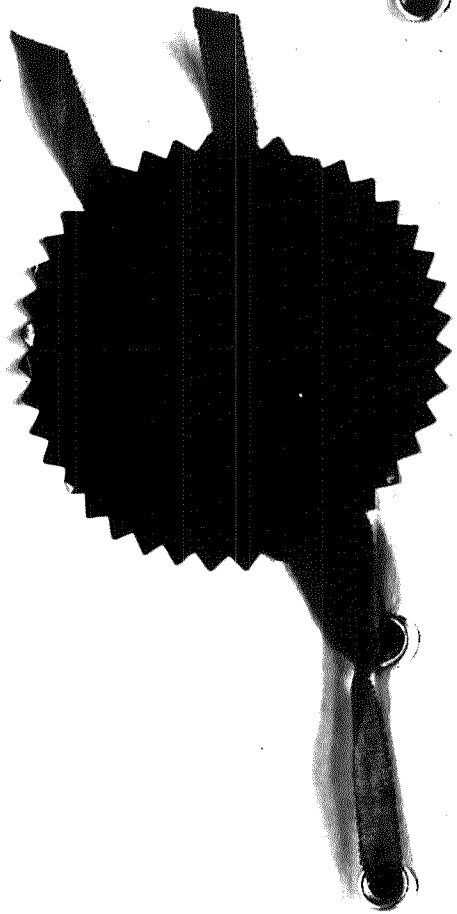

To a stake in a stone mound Station No. 17 of the Rancho San Pascual. |
