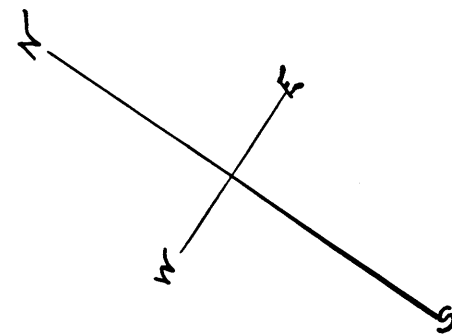


Showing the assessment district and the land to be taken for widening of Mercer Avenue in the City of Pasadena on its South westerly side from a point Six hundred and sixty six and two thirds feet northwesterly from the northwesterly line of Orange Grove Avenue northwesterly to its present terminus, also showing the land assessed and the relative location of each district, block, lot, portion of lot or parcel of land and its dimensions each block, lot or portion of lot taken or assessed is designated and described by the number marked thereon in red ink. Herein the mark ' means feet. Figures in black ink next to property lines show each the length of said line in feet. Other figures in black ink show the numbers of the lots. Continuous black lines show the original lot lines. Broken black lines show subdivisions of lots. Green shading shows land to be taken for the widening of said Mercer Avenue. Red shading shows the boundary of the assessment district. Other shading shows the boundaries of the subdivisions named. The plat is drawn to a scale of 100 ft to one inch.

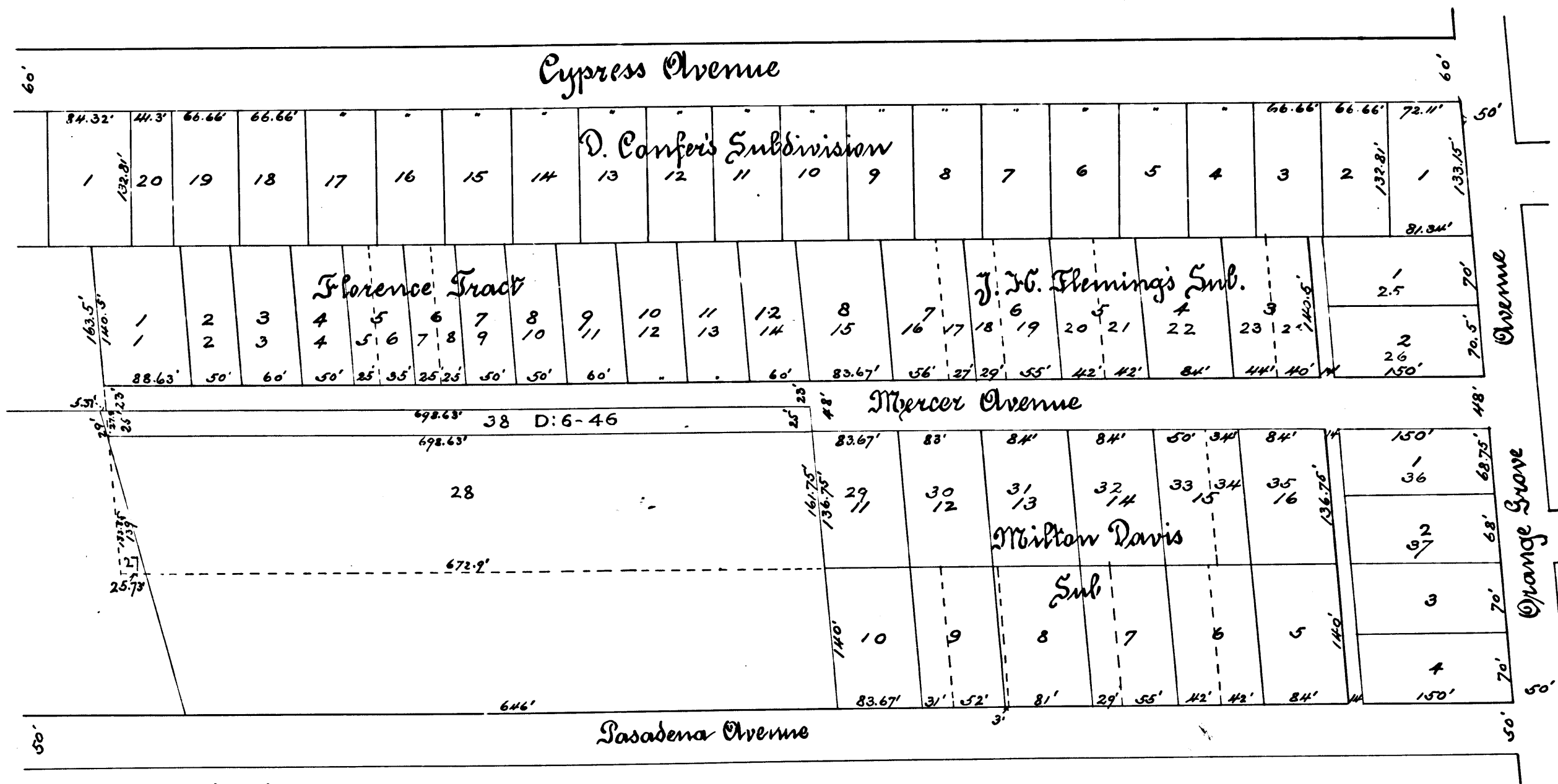
