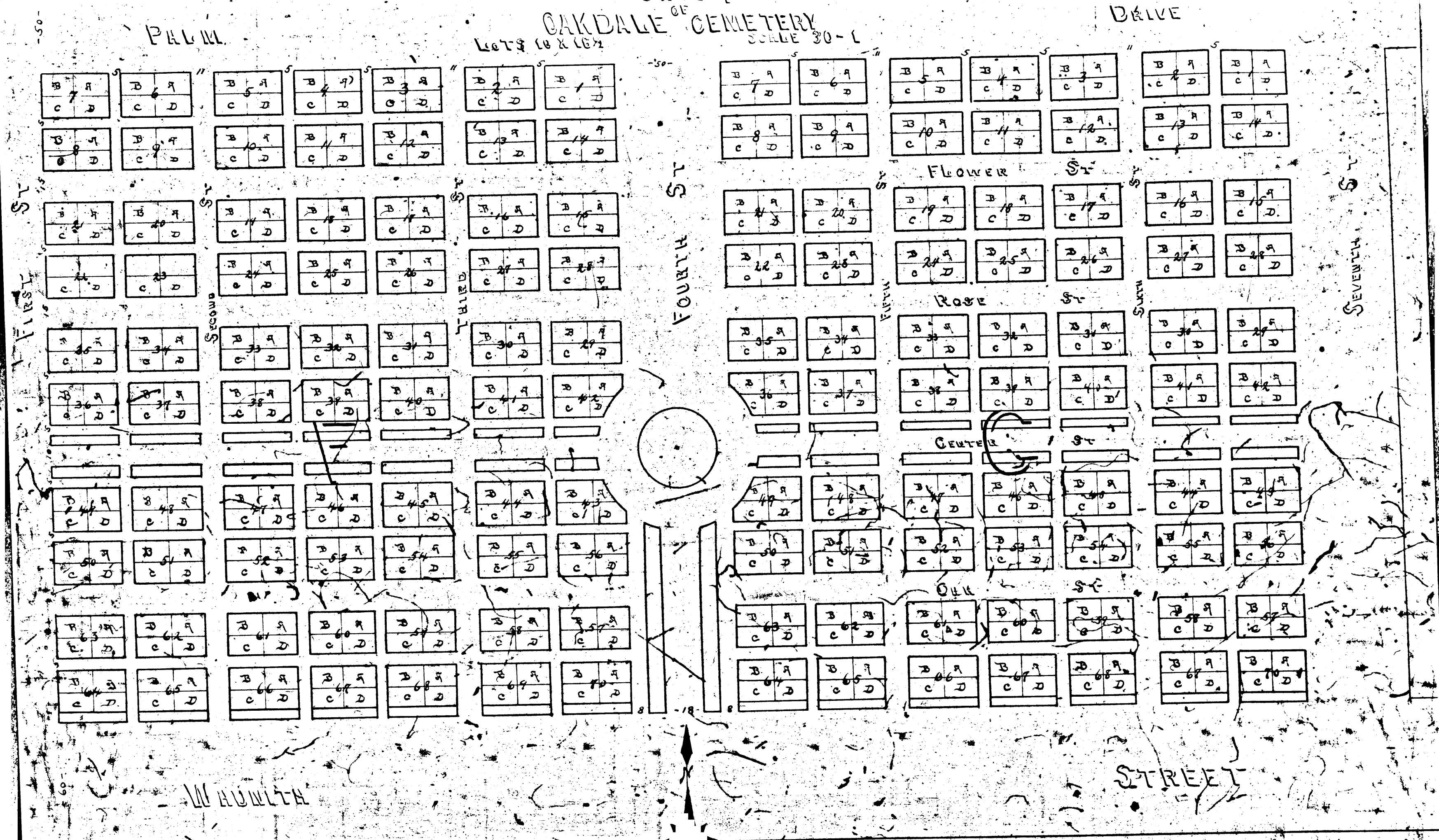


PORTION OF
