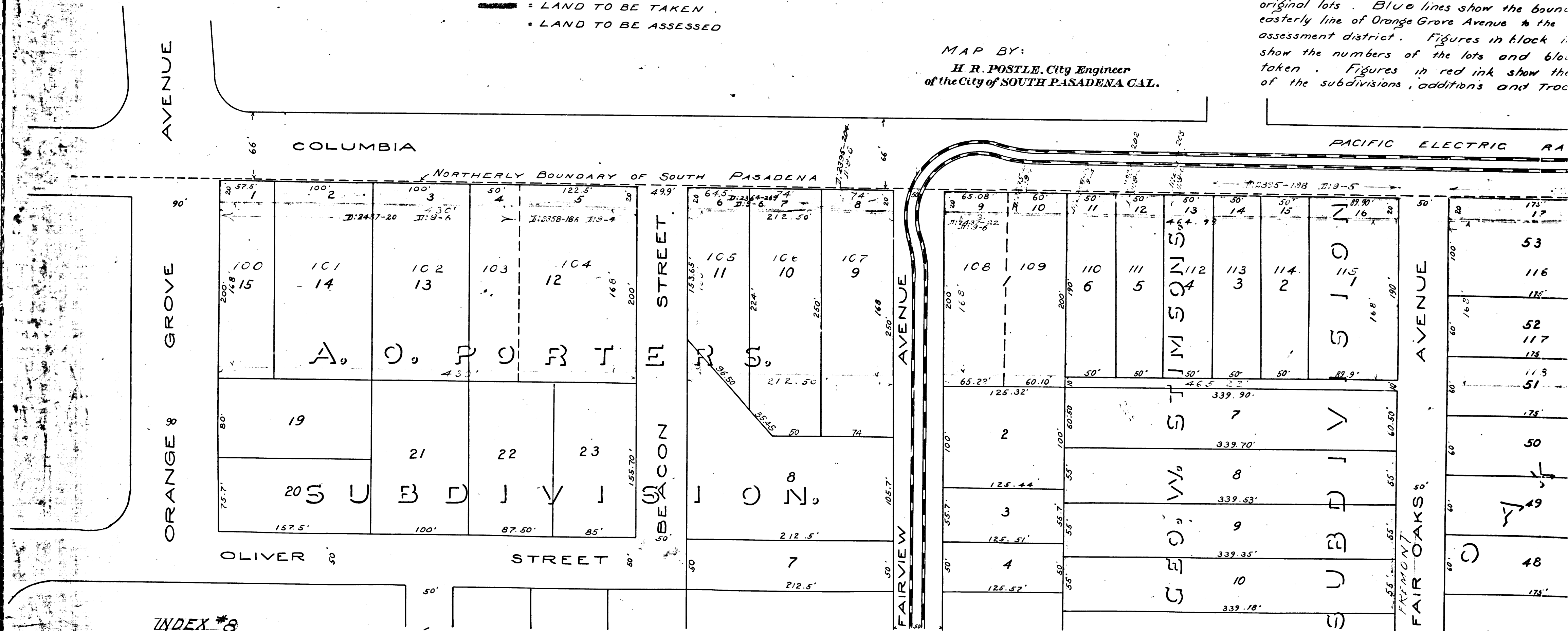

 ASSESSED TO PAY THE DAMAGES, COST AND EXPENSES THEREOF.

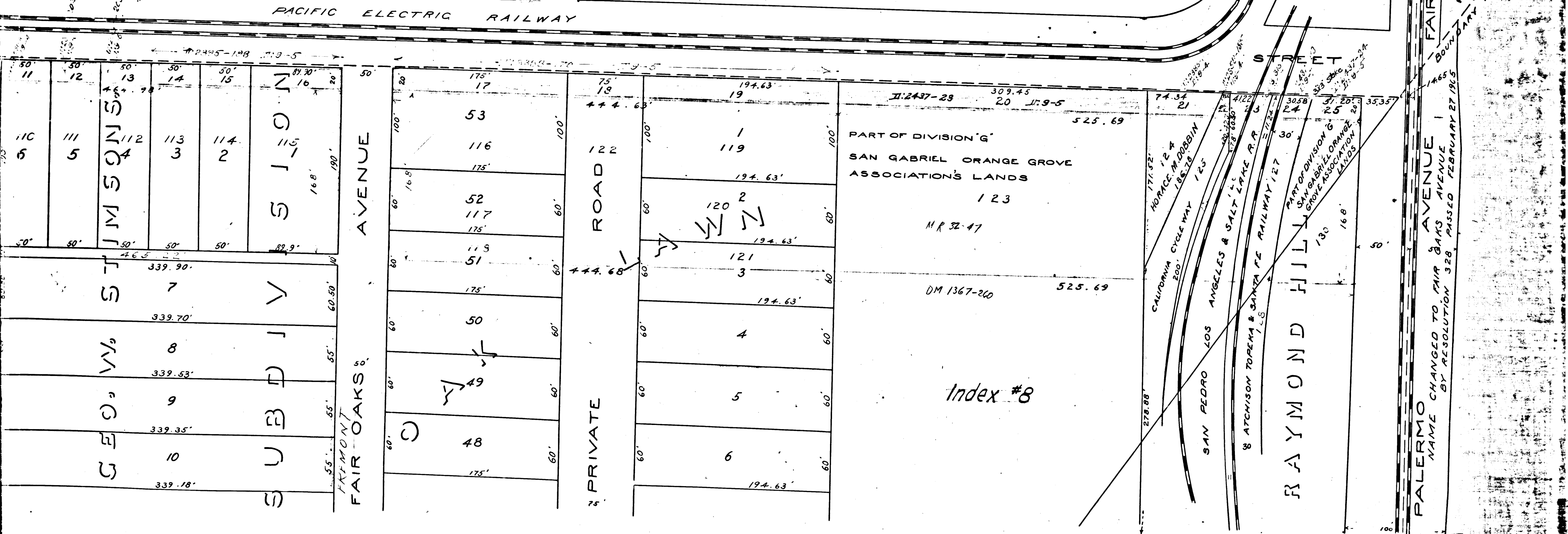
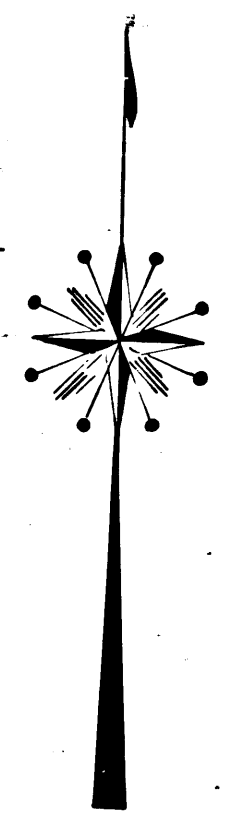

The map shows the relative location of each district, block, lot, portion or parcel of land assessed, together with its dimensions. Each block, lot or portion of lot taken or assessed is designated and described by the number marked hereon in orange ink. Hereon continuous black lines show original lot lines. Dotted black lines show subdivisions of the original lots. Blue lines show the boundaries of the lands to be taken for the opening of Columbia Street from the easterly line of Orange Grove Avenue to the westerly line of Palermo Avenue. Red lines show the boundaries of the assessment district. Figures in black ink next to lot lines show the lengths of said lines; other figures in black ink show the numbers of the lots and blocks. Figures in blue ink show the dimensions of the lands to be taken. Figures in red ink show the dimensions of the assessment district. Tintings show the boundaries of the subdivisions, additions and tracts named.
