**DIAGRAM.**

Exhibiting the assessment district and the land to be taken for the opening of Fillmore Street in the City of Pasadena, California, from the west line of Los Robles Avenue to the east line of Euclid Avenue and from the west line of Euclid Avenue to the east line of Magnolia Avenue, also showing the land assessed and the relative location of each district, block, lot, portion of lot or parcel of land, and its dimensions. Each block, lot, portion of lot or parcel of land taken or assessed is designated and described by the number marked thereon in red ink.

Hereon the mark "f" means feet. Figures in black ink next to property lines show each the length of said lines in feet. Other figures in black ink show the numbers of the lots. Solid black lines show original lot lines; broken black lines show subdivisions of original lots. Red, green, and brown tintings show boundaries of subdivisions named. Orange tinting shows boundary of the assessment district. Blue tinting shows lands to be taken for the opening of Fillmore Street.

The diagram is drawn to the scale of one hundred feet to one inch.
