413 showing Alignment and Right of Way along Rubio Storm Drain No. 2

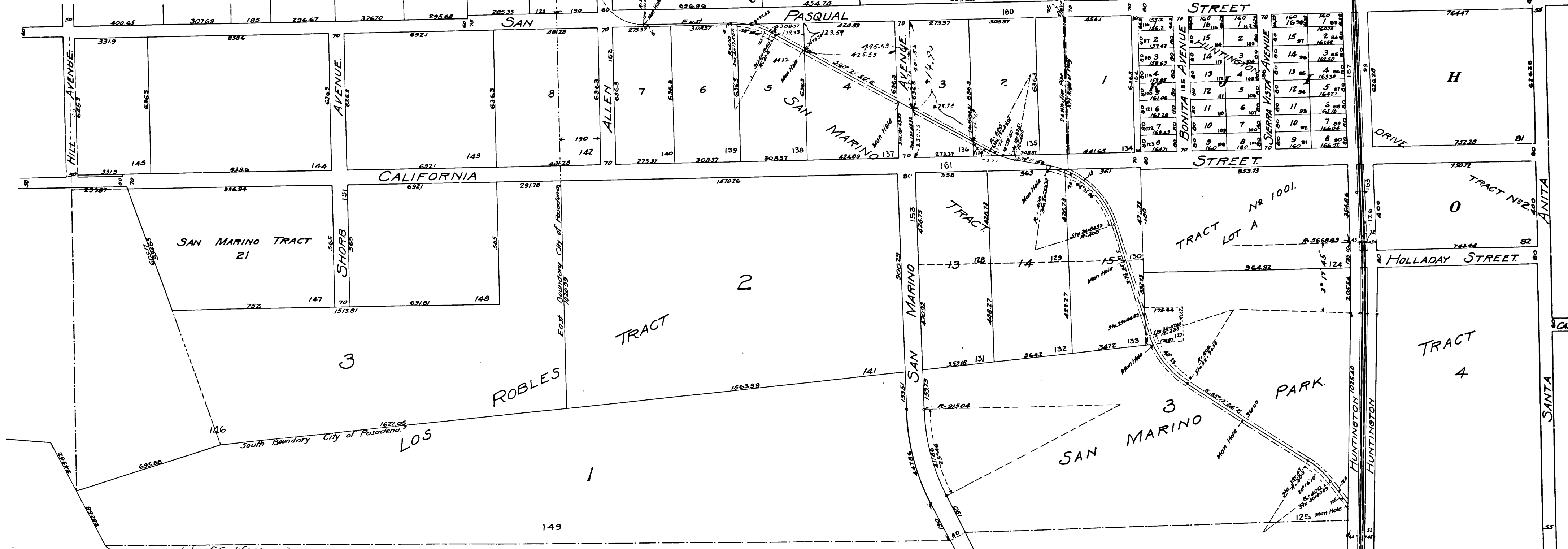
FROM SAN PASQUAL ST. SOUTH TO HUNTINGTON DR.
